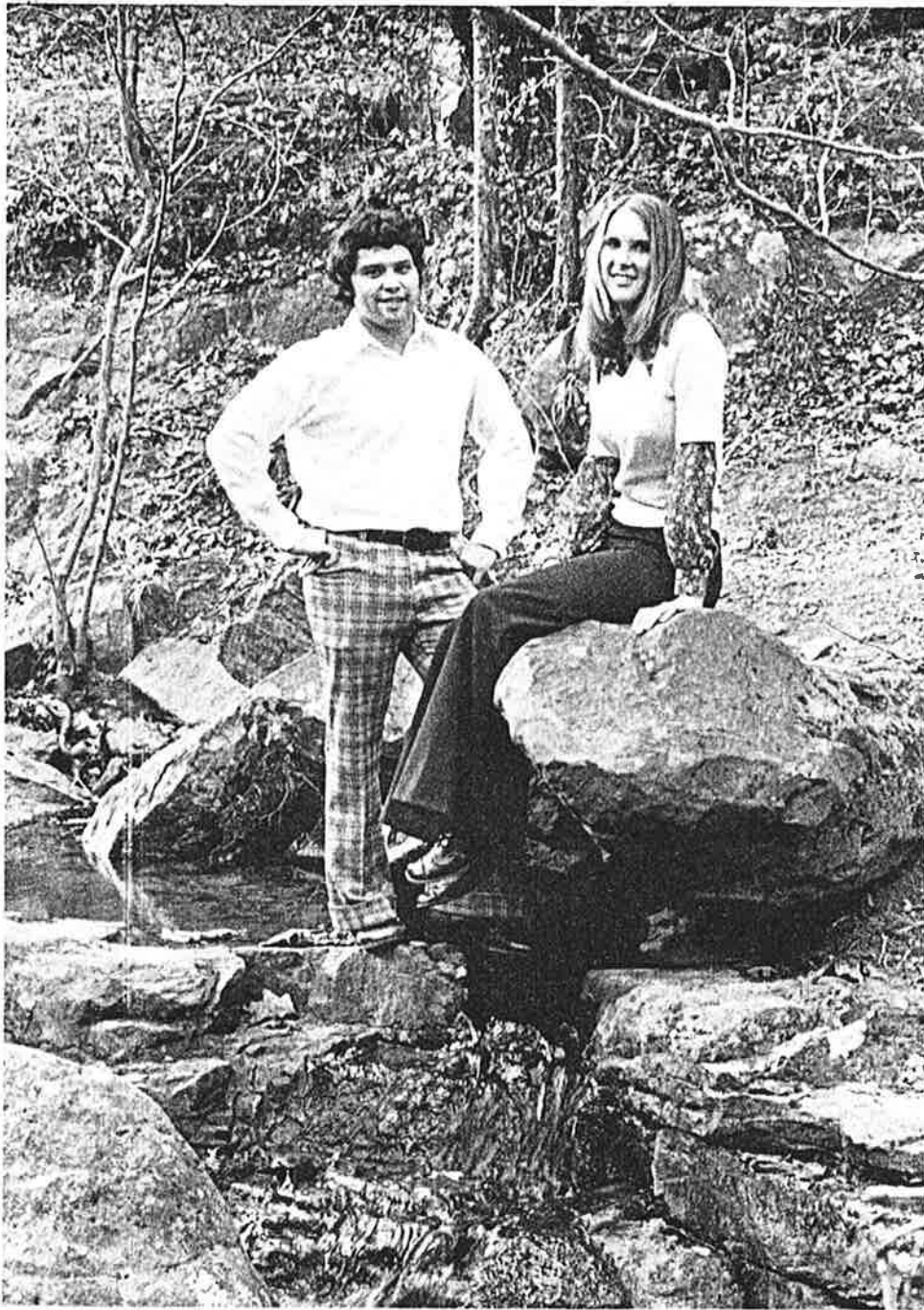
Tonight we present Spring Sing, a presentation of music by a majority of our social clubs, a few individual students as well as members of our faculty.
