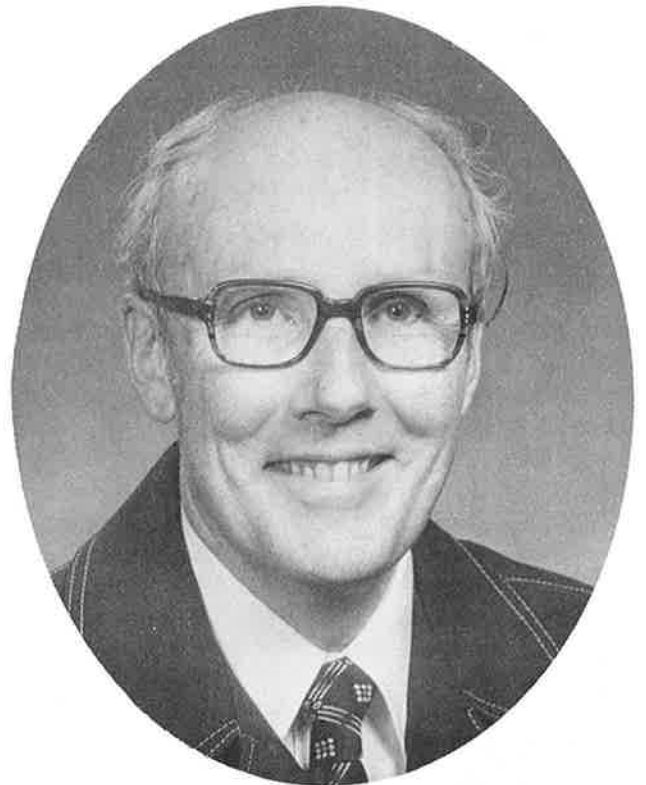

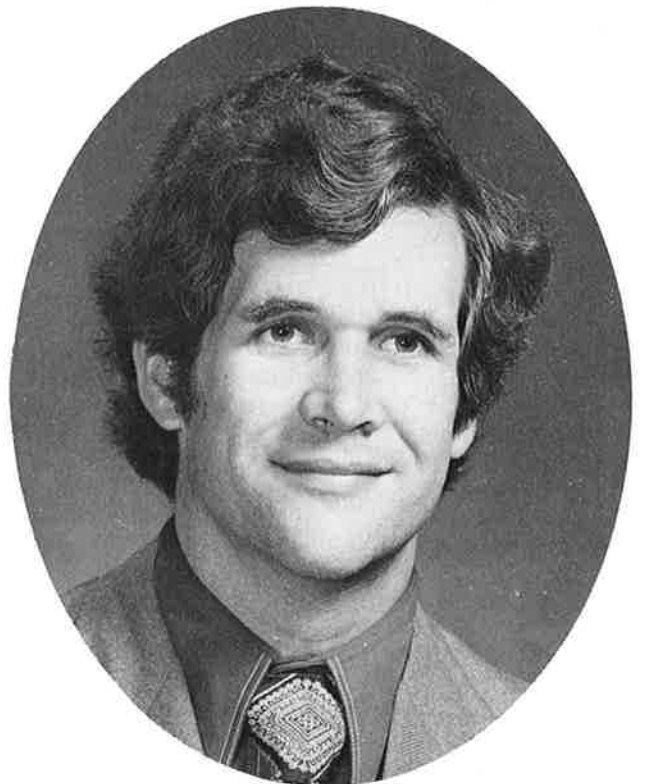
**John H. Ryan**  
**Coordinator**

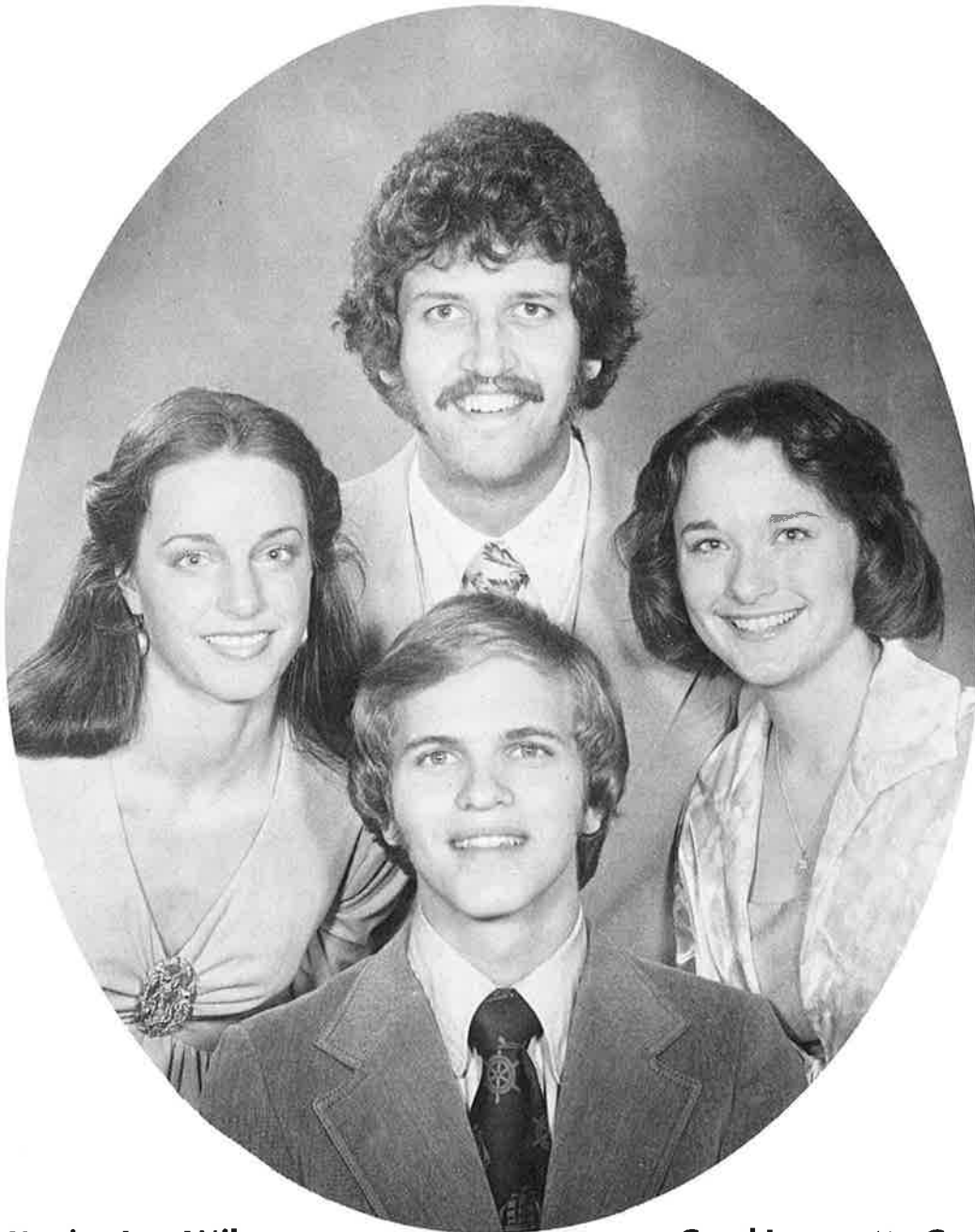

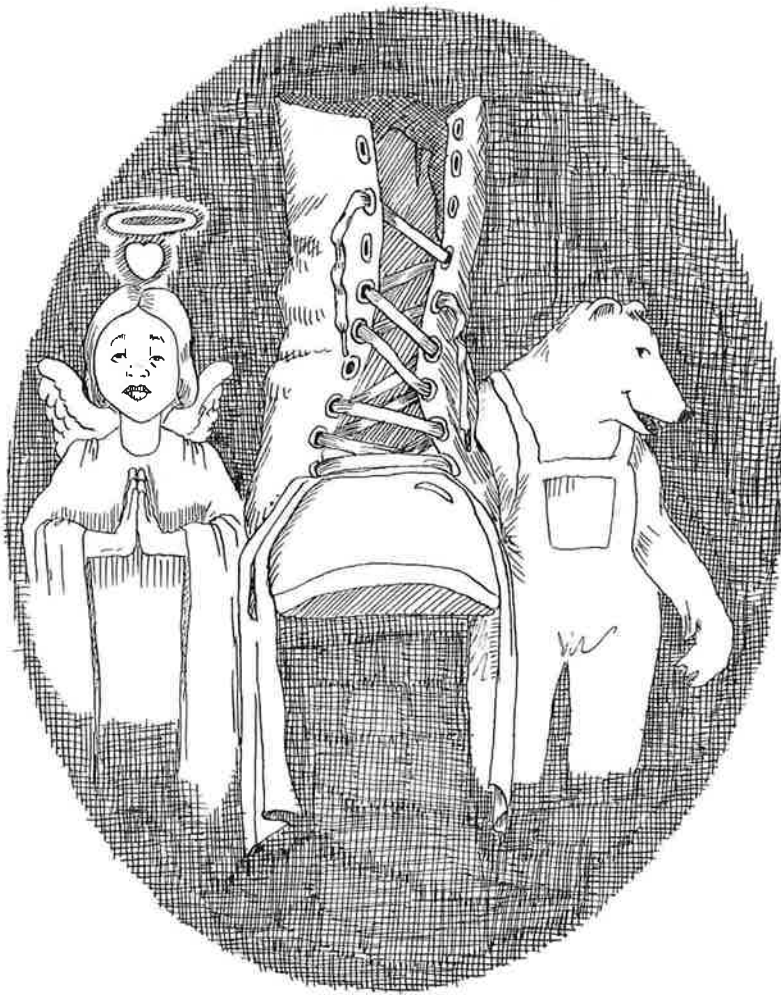

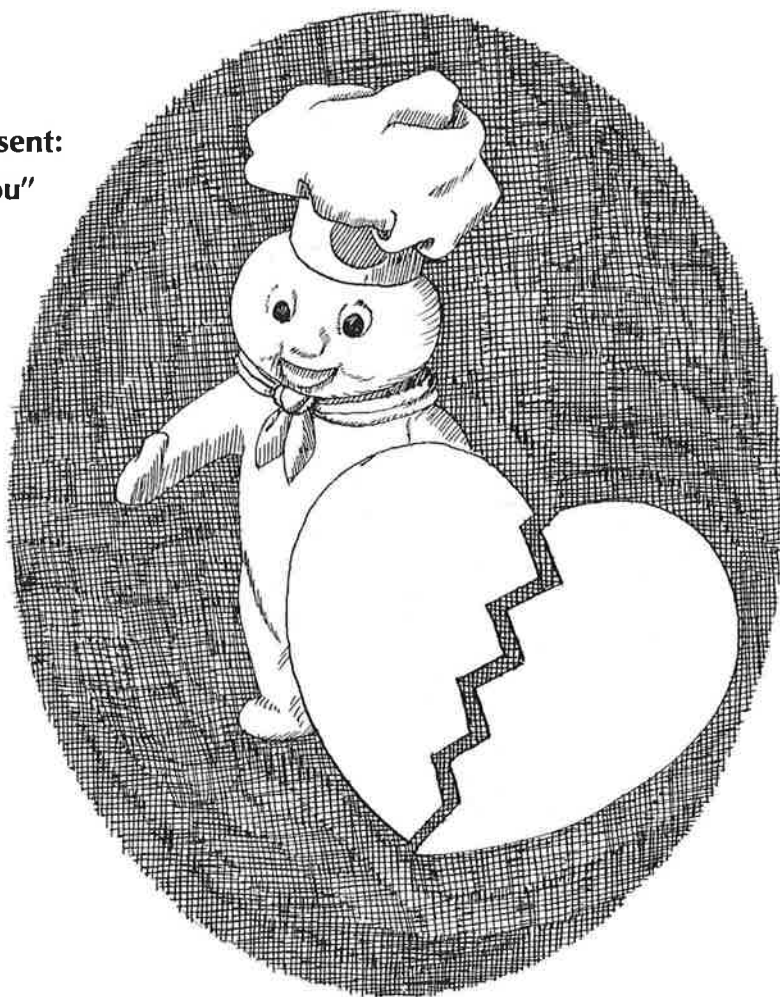
