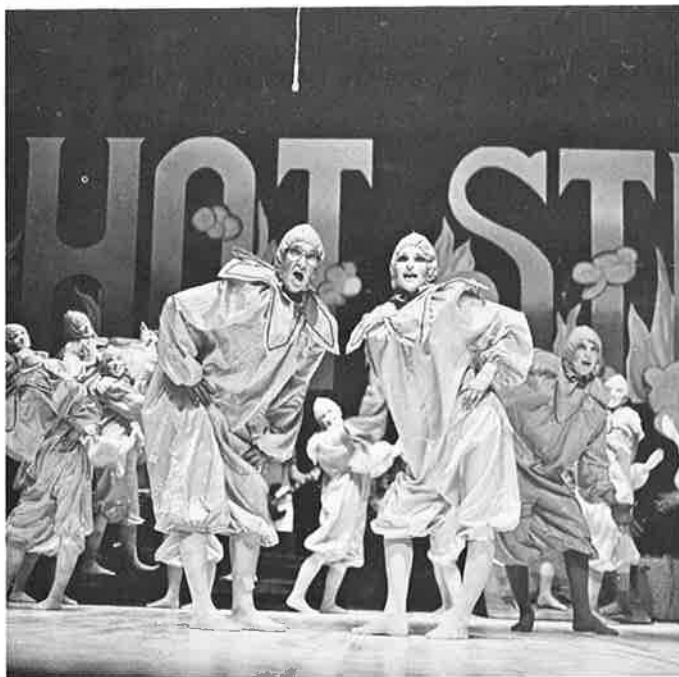

Technical Director

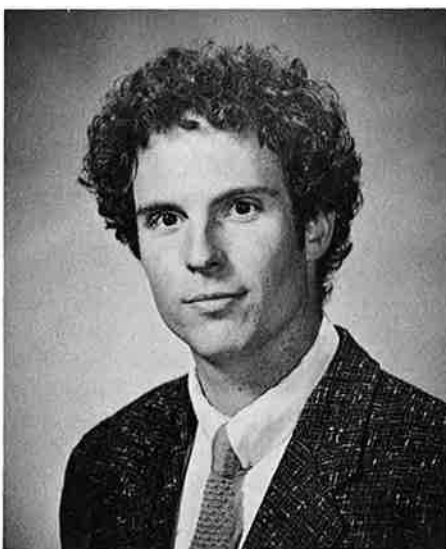
