### Bill Anthony

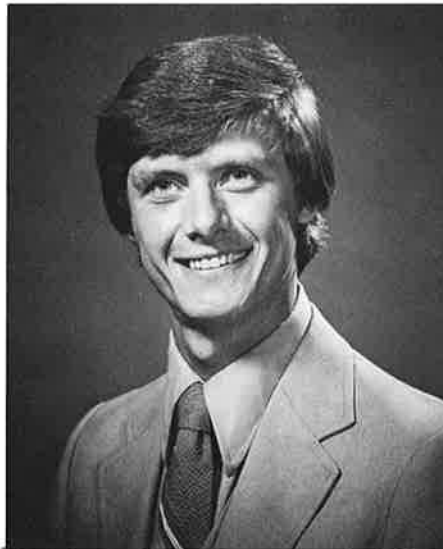
