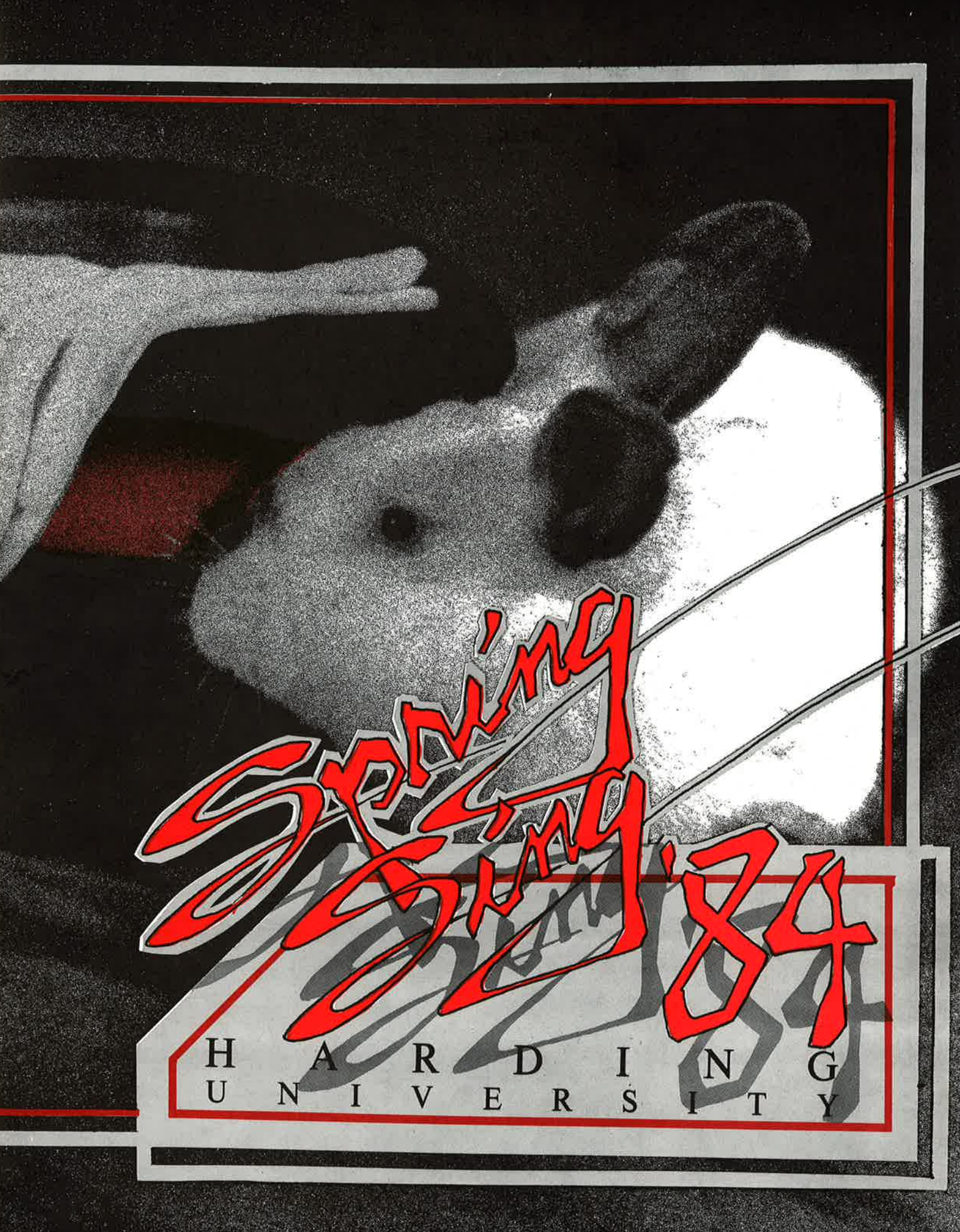

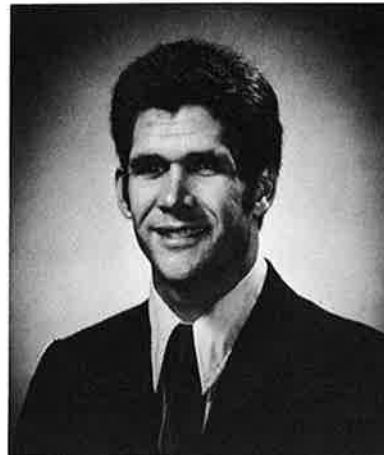
Veronica Williams

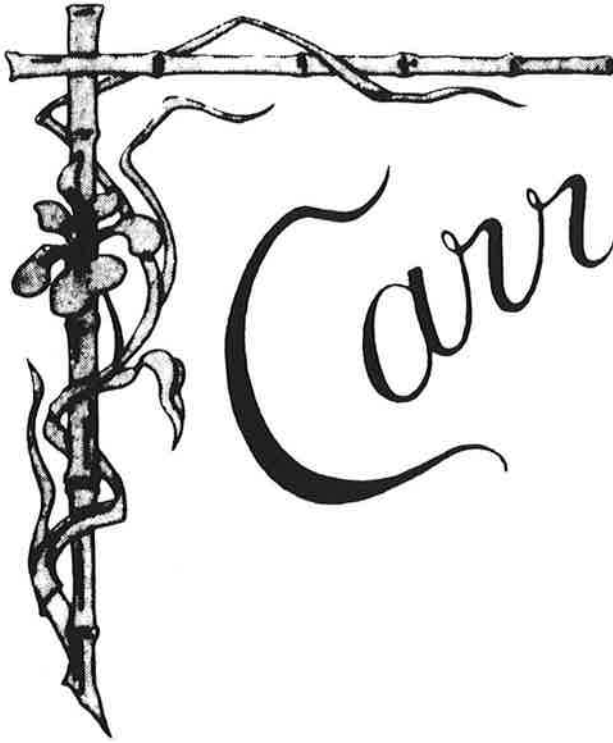
