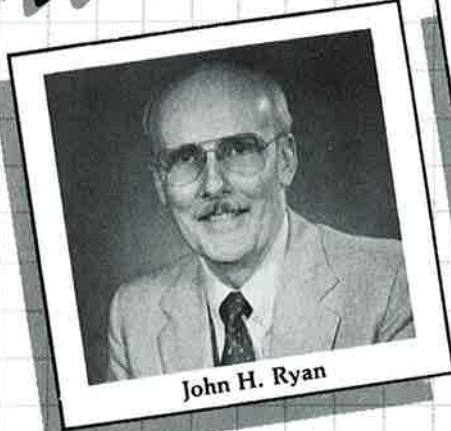
## Sharon Healy

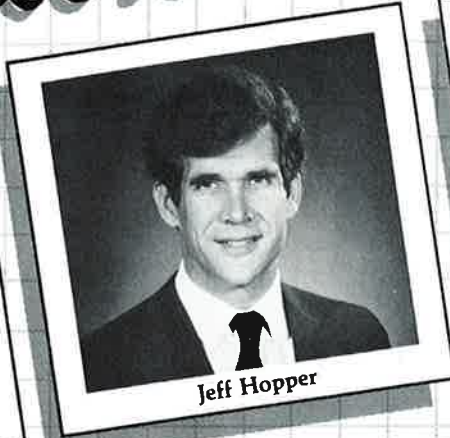
## Tim Dill
