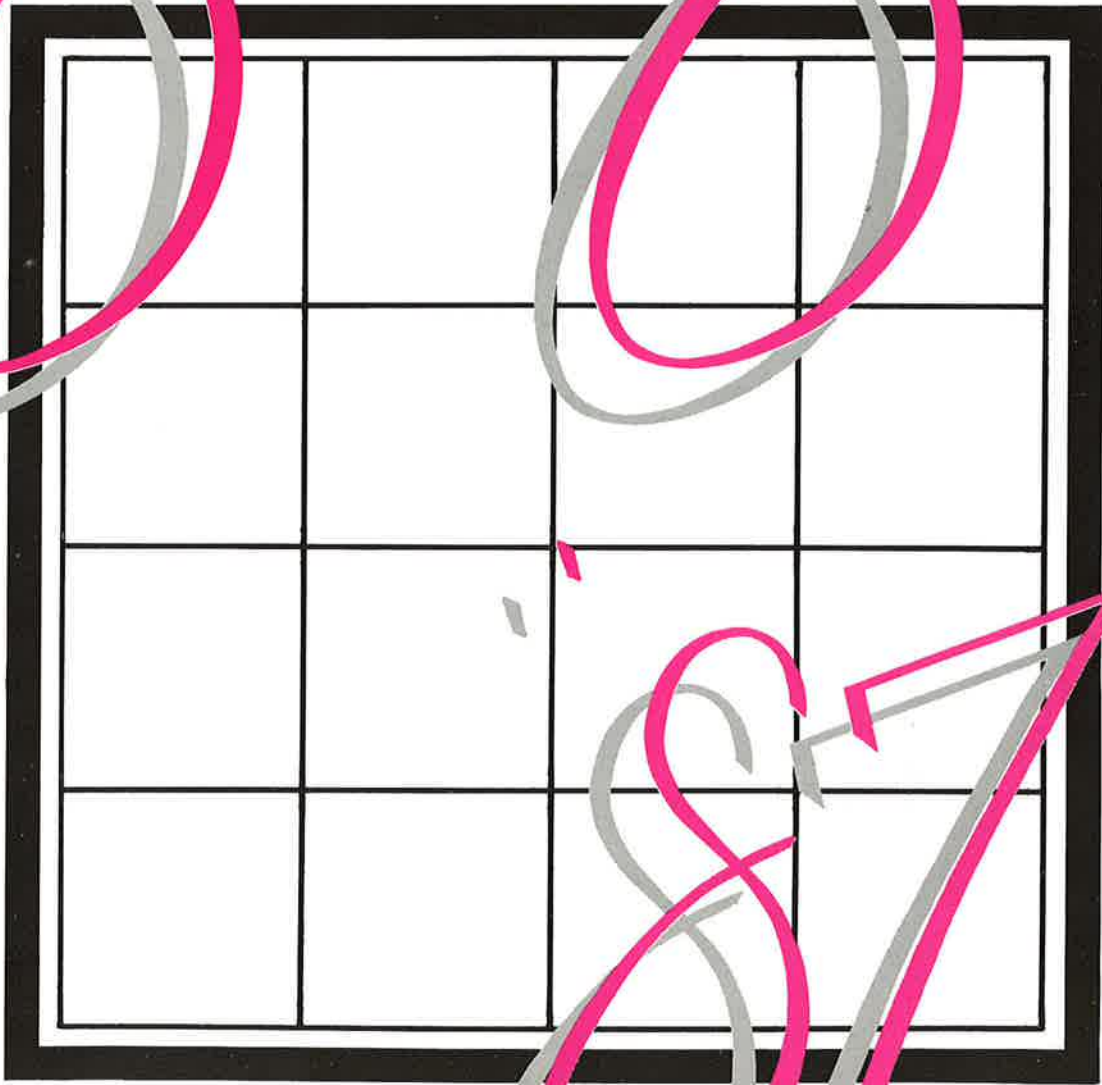

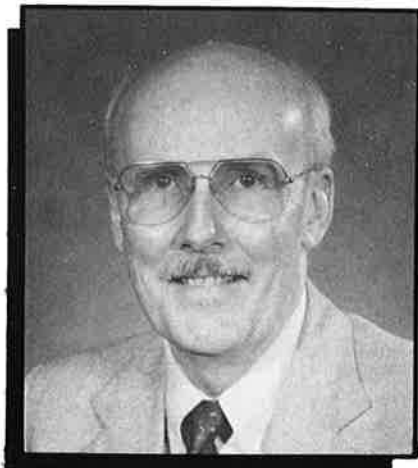
Terrance Dwight Talley

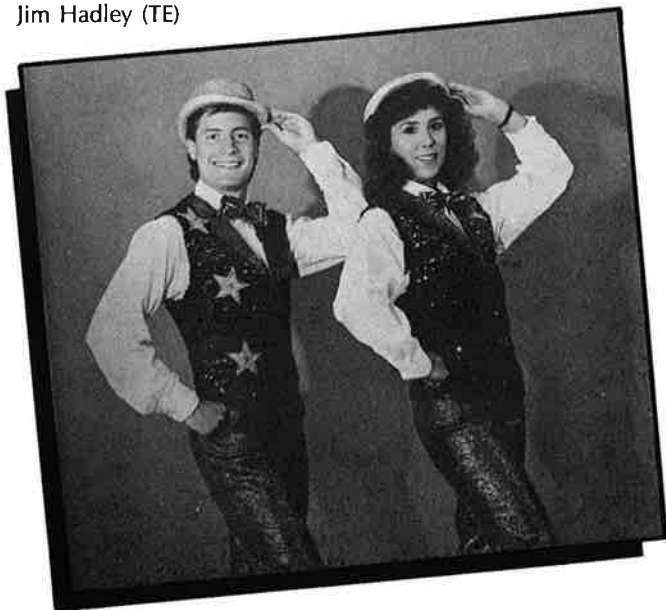
