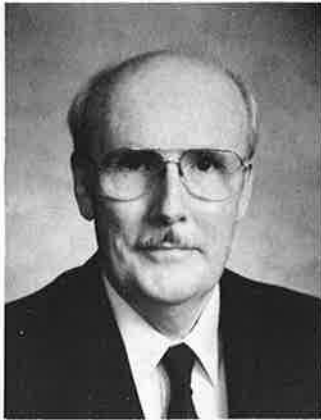

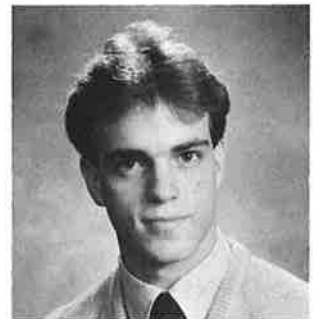
BOB RITCHIE
