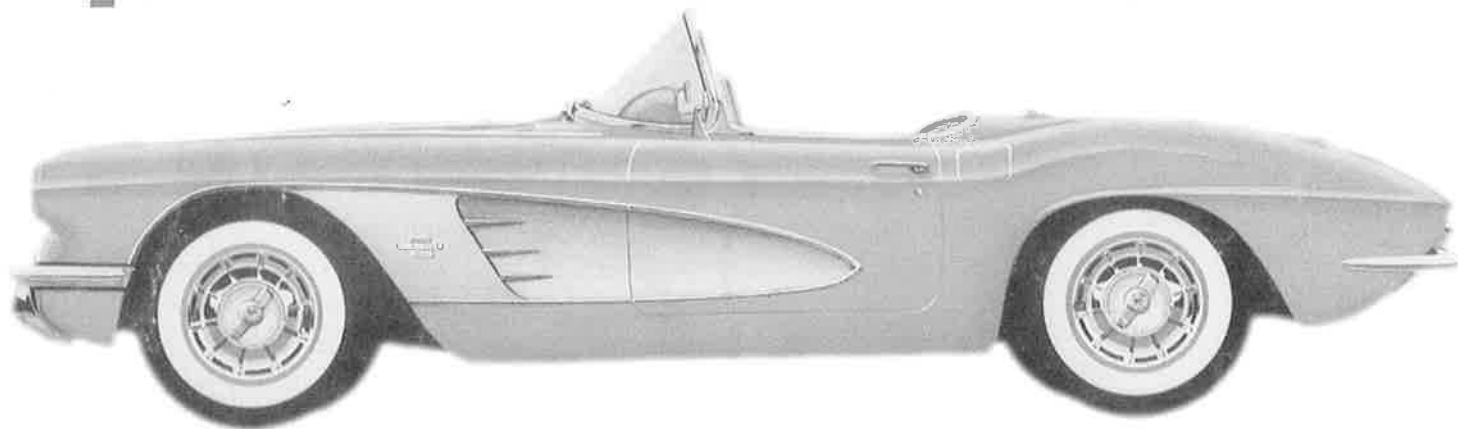
# A BLESSED HISTORY
