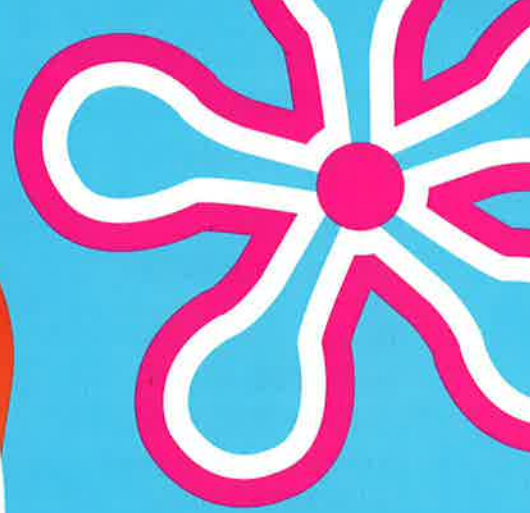

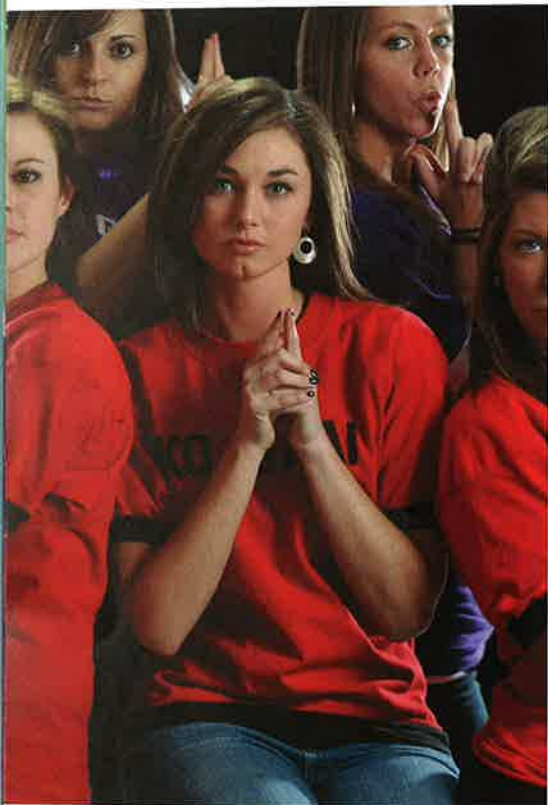

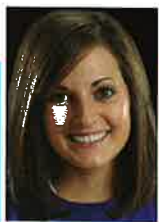

It can come in the joy of the everyday and the in the transcendent moments in our life. It may come with a smile as we look back on a life well spent.

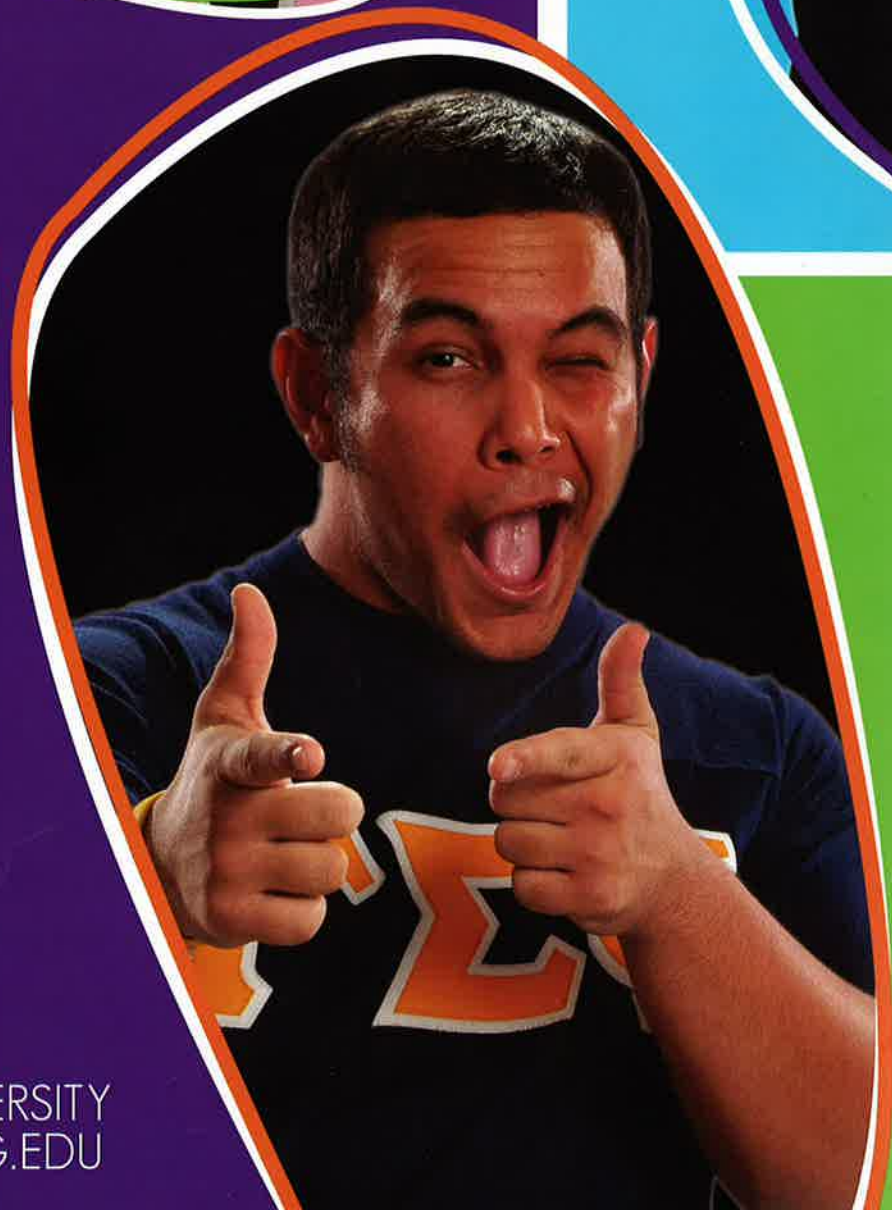
