Honesty in Thanksgiving

READ COLOSSIANS 1:9-20

Bible Thought: "Giving thanks unto the Father . . ." (Colossians 1:12).

col. 3:12. Eph. 5:20.

THESE marvelous words of praise and thanksgiving expressed by Paul indicate his recognition of God for his greatness in giving mankind a Savior. Paul had perhaps earlier thought that he was self-sufficient and had a great deal of personal strength, but after he came to know the gift of God in Christ, his whole life was changed.

Since the beginning of human life on the earth, man has been trying to steal the glory and praise that belongs to God. Even after we become Christians, it is easy to take the credit for the things that God accomplishes in our life. It is probably true that there is a good deal too much of the "I" in the conversation of most of us!

Let us learn from the example of Paul that all praise and honor belong to the Father and to his Christ and to the Holy Spirit. By ourselves, we can do nothing that is really worthwhile. With God at work in us, we can do all things that he desires. It is dishonest to take the credit for what someone else has done. Let us give thanks, honor, and praise to God continually.

READING suggests several things:

1. Since the beginning man has been trying to steal the glory and praise which belongs to God. *Was Satan's key suggestion: Gen. 3:1-6* True!*
2. Mankind today (Christians included) tend to take credit which belongs to God.
3. Paul learned to give God ALL the praise and ALL the glory, which were rightfully His.
4. WE will BE better, DO better, and ACCOMPLISH more, when we learn to give God the full measure of praise, honor and glory due Him.
