I The Real David

1. Acts 13:21-23. David had to have been a great man:

- a. God called him "a man after my own heart." ^{super compliment}
- b. a man "who would do all God's will."
- c. The messiah came thru his seed.
- d. David a King, good one, and a type of Christ.

2. 1 Sam. 13:13-14. David selected to succeed Saul because he - DAVID - WAS a man after God's own heart, or of an obedient and righteous disposition.

3. Wait! What of David's transgressions...?
a. What did he do? Worship idols? No! Build altars to heathen Gods? No! Lead Israel to disobey God? No! Lead Israel to be immoral? No!

Then, as a leader, he obeyed God and led Israel to obey God! Yes! Great National leader for 40 years! His public life was exemplary!

b. Question: what of his private life? Failed miserably!
Human. Fleshly. a thief. a liar. an adulterer. a murderer.

c. Question: How then a man after God's own heart?? Acts 13:22 a Historical Overview of Israel. a capsule of Personalities + Events; Generalities, not details.

- c. Simple - do as David did. When he sinned he acknowledged that he had offended God. Luke 13:3! More than ever want to be pure in heart; + hunger + thirst after righteousness!
