MEETING

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Executive Council of the Student Association of Harding College met Tuesday night at eitht o'clock in the Seminar Koom of the Library. The meeting was opened by a prayer led by Prof. Pitner, sponsor. The ibusiness discussed was as follows:

1. Harding College is to be host to Career Day on March 28. Paul Magee, Winfred Wright, Jane Sutherlin, and Joan Nance are to make short talks of 5 minutes to acquaint the students with the various activities at Harding. The theme of the day will be "Youth Looks Ahead."

2. The council discussed Senior's exemption from final tests. The resolution was made and passed that a senior having a high <u>B</u> aberage or above in any particular course may be exempt from the final examination in that class provided that it is agreeable with the instructor of the course and that the student has had previous examinations in the course to merit a grade. Realizing the heavy load **p** placed on seniors who have worked hard the last few weeks of school the council feel that it would be a great privelege for them to be exempt. A letter is being sent To Dean Sears asking the Academic Affairs Committee to consider out request.

3. The council discussed ways in which we could aid in the building of the park. Paul is to urge all students to help in chapel speech, friday.

The meeting was closed by a prayer led by TommynParish, senior class president and representaive to the council.
