CHRIST'S TRIUMPHAL ENTRY

29-45.

John 12:12-19\* (M.21:1-11, Mk.11:1-11, Lk.19:9)

I. BACKGROUND: The Growing Reputation of Jesus.

A. MIRACLES..... 11

- 1. Water to wine at Cana of Galilee. J2:1-11. *disciples believed.*
- 2. Nobleman's son at Cana. John 4:46-54. *man believed.*
- 3. Jer.: Cripple for 38 yrs. 5:1-16. *Growing host of believers.*
- 4. 5,000 fed. 6:1-15. Greater popularity. *Materialistic interest.*
- 5. Walked on water. 6:16-21.
- 6. Cured man born blind at Jer. 9:1-41. *Man believed - many*
- 7. Bethany: Raised Lazarus. 11:1-46. *Martha believed many more.*

PURPOSE: John 20:30-31.

EFFECTS: John 12:42. 12:9-11\*

B. A KING.....

- 1. Fed 5,000. Zealots. 6:15. Can conquer!!
- 2. Triumphal Entry. v. 13-15. Save us!!!
- 3. Pilate's question. 18:37, 33-36\*
- 4. Caiaphas. Matt. 26:62-66. Blasphemy.
- 5. Pilate's reticence. 19:12-16. YOUR KING
- 6. Paul: I Tim. 1:15-17. I Tim. 6:15.

CONFUSION: Some expected an overthrow of Rome; others, erection of Spr. Kingdom.

II. BACKGROUND: Jesus' Spec.-Personal Prep. Pass-

A. All Jews attended Passover possible over.

- 1. Josephus: One year: 256,500 lambs slain. X ten to lamb = 2 Million, 700,000 there. \*John 11:54-57. Question????? He come?

B. John 12:1-2. Jesus waited for Passover.

C. Sent for colt of a donkey. M. 21:1-7. (Isa. 62:11. and (Zech. 9:9)

III. THE SENSATIONAL TRIUMPHAL ENTRY.

- 1. Group from Bethany-Galileans. Knew miracle *Lazarus*
- 2. Group from Jerusalem. Heard of miracles.
- 3. Clothes laid on donkey: Way with Kings.
- 4. Palm branches & clothes on ground. 12:13.
- 5. What was said: (1st time accepted acclaim) (over)

John 19:35

"NOTAR" FORUM & PEASE "NOTAR" (R)

*Earthly Kingdom.*

- a. Matt. 21:9. "Hosanna: to the Son of David. Blessed is He that cometh in the NAME of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest."
- b. Mark 11:9-10. "Hosanna: Blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord. Blessed be the kingdom of our father David that cometh in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest." (30.116:25-26) *Worldly.*
- c. Luke 19:38. "Blessed be the King that cometh in the name of the Lord: peace in heaven and glory in the highest." *Spiritual !!*
- d. John 12:13. "Hosanna: Blessed is the king of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord." NAME: Meant authority and/or power.
- 6. Proceeded to cleanse the temple, and heal many Untouchable at this time!!! Great popularity

IV. SIGNIFICIANCE OF THE TRIUMPHAL ENTRY.

- A. Unridden Colt: Animal of Kings. Sacred-un<sup>us</sup>ed
- B. *Donkey* Colt: Symbol of Peace. Horse, symbol of war. (Disenchanted some-materialistic. Want: General)
- C. *10ft* Palms: red-carpet for Kings & Conquerers: were spread in the path of Triumphant Conquerers *Self up Kingdom Now!*
- D. Cloaks spread: Victorious Kings too sacred to walk on common ground or even their beasts. III. 1836 Bethlehem wanted British protection in TurkoEgyptian War. Spread garments in pathway of British Consul-seeking favor.
- E. "HOSANNA": = Save now! God save us. Save now we beseech Thee! LIKE: God save the king!!!
- F. STONES: Lk. 19:39-40. Pharisees wanted silence Reply: If Humanity kept quiet all NATURE would speak out. God will be glorified!!
- G. JESUS ACCEPTED THE PRAISE AND ACCLAIM!!! Why? Was due their King, Messiah & Savior.
