Dear Brother Evans:

I hope this letter finds all your family and my many friends at the church in good health. I hope that your work there is progressing and that the meeting was an encouragement to all.

We have just concluded our eight-day meeting with Bro. W. A. Bradfield. Our crowds averaged 272 each evening. On three evenings our attendance was 311, 317 and 330. As far as responses are concerned, we certainly were blessed. Forty-three people responded to the invitation. Of that number 31 were baptisms and 12 restorations.

This letter is written to inform you of the progress of our work here and our prayers are for your continued success in the work of the Lord in Marmaduke.
