MINUTES

A meeting of the SA Council was held on February 24, 1960, in the SA Office.

Business attended to was as follows:

1. The Council decided to outline the program for the rest of the year and to take positive action in their relationship toward the Administration. Means of positive action are as follows:
 1. More all student body meetings to inform students of Council's work.
 2. Survey of what students expect of SA
 3. Open SA meetings
 4. SA representatives report in class meetings
 5. Memos on SA bulletin board of SA meetings and results of their recommendations to the Administration.
2. Mike Maple's report on the obtaining of a bus for the colored congregation stated that only \$15.00 came from the SA treasury and that better than 80% of the social clubs participated in the project.
3. The SA financial status was discussed; and, it was reported that it was in good condition. Since the movie fund was ahead, it was suggested colored movies be obtained.
4. The Council decided to report to the student body concerning their projects and their plans. The plans will be given at an all-student body meeting on March 1, 1960.
5. The SA Council will be in charge of Chapel on March 25, 1960.
6. Claudette Faulk was appointed to contact Ralph Martiri to see if he could present a concert on our campus on March 15.
7. It was reported that the students are in favor of a "Dead Day"; efforts will be made to obtain it for this semester.
8. A letter from Gary Smith to correct a misunderstanding

of a letter sent to Dr. Benson was read.

The meeting was then adjourned.
