Chief cause of religious division is ignorance of Bible.  
 Chief cause of ignorance is difference in God's laws.

LNT: Proper understanding includes: time written, place, whom written to and the purpose of the law.

Study God's various laws in relation to us today.

I. GOD'S ANCIENT LAWS.

- A. First law to man. Keep garden. Gen. 2:15. Binding on us?
- B. Second law. Eat not the forbidden fruit. Gen. 2:16.
- C. Third law. Law of matrimony. Genesis 2:24.
- D. Patriarchal law given to Noah, Abram, Isaac and Jacob.
  1. Eating of blood forbidden. Gen. 9:4. Simple code.
  2. Murderer punished with death. Gen. 9:6 / Gen. 22:13
  3. Worship—simple alter ceremony with animal sacrifice.
  4. Great promise made to Abraham. Not law. Gen. 12:1-3.
- E. Law of Moses given after the Egyptian bondage.
  1. Passover feast a Jewish law. Ex. 13:9. Not binding now
  2. Ten Commandments given at Sinai to Moses. Ex. 20:1-17
  3. Host of other laws and ordinances given. Col. 2:14
- F. Laws for the Tabernacle worship given Moses. Ex. 25
  1. God to dwell in the Most Holy Place. vs. 8
  2. Priests ordained to execute the worship. 28:1-2
  3. Animals sacrificed for sins as their worship. 29
  4. Incense burned every morning and evening. 30:7-8.
  5. Tabernacle laws continued into the temple worship.

II. GOD'S NEW LAW.

- A. Law of grace and truth. John 1:17. Romans 6:14.
- B. Moses' law served its purpose. Matt. 17:1-5.
- C. God speaks to us only through His Son now. Heb. 1:1-2.
- D. This makes Christ and Moses agree perfectly. Deut. 18:15

  1. Law a schoolmaster till Seed should come. Gal. 3:24-25

  1. Law rolled sins forward one year. Heb. 10:3-4.
  2. Sins forever forgiven through Christ. Heb. 10:14-20.
