

CATHLEEN SHULTZ, PH.D.

Dr. Cathleen Shultz serves as dean of Carr College of Nursing. A member of the nursing faculty since 1976, she was named chairperson of the department in 1977 and then in 1980 became the founding dean of the college. She has a B.S.N. from the University of South Carolina, an M.N. from Emory University, and a Ph.D. from Vanderbilt University.

Shultz was the first Arkansan elected to the national board of governors of the National League for Nursing (NLN) and the only Arkansan to serve as president of the organization.

Under Shultz's leadership, Carr College of Nursing was the first nursing program in Arkansas to use computers as a part of learning, introduce primary care in the curriculum, provide health services for Head Start and HIPPY programs, initiate health screening clinics in public schools, provide health information and services for the elderly, and incorporate health missions into the curriculum. She recently led the college into the state-of-the-art \$9 million Swaid Center and led in the planning for graduate programs soon to be offered.

Shultz was appointed by Governors Bill Clinton and Mike Beebe to serve on the Arkansas State Board of Nursing. She is currently serving her fourth term on the governing body. She was elected to serve as president of the board from 1991-92. She is currently chair of the board's education committee.

Her many honors include twice being named Distinguished Teacher at Harding, selected as Outstanding Alumna from the University of South Carolina College of Nursing, honored with the 2010 Distinguished Service Award from the Arkansas Nurses' Association, recognized with her induction in 1992 as a Fellow of the American Academy of Nursing, chosen in 2009 as a Fellow of the Arkansas Gerontological Society, and named in 2012 as a Fellow of the Academy of Nurse Educators.

Her community and gerontology nursing expertise received numerous recognitions including the 2008 American Association of Colleges of Nursing Outstanding Award for Innovation in Baccalaureate Geriatric Nursing Education from the Hartford Foundation.

Shultz's professional memberships include the American Nurses' Association; the Arkansas Nurses' Association; the NLN; and Sigma Theta Tau, the international honor society for nurses. Her husband is Dr. Sam Shultz, a pediatrician at Arkansas Children's Hospital.



PAUL POLLARD, PH.D.

Dr. Paul Pollard is professor of Greek and New Testament within the College of Bible and Ministry. He grew up in Atlanta, Ga., and attended Georgia State University as a history major. While in Georgia he served eight years in the military police in the Georgia National Guard. He holds a B.S. in Bible and Greek from Lipscomb University and a M.A. and M.Div. from Harding School of Theology in Memphis. After graduate study at Oxford University, he finished the Ph.D. in New Testament studies at Baylor University. Post-doctoral work includes study at Pepperdine University and Andover-Newton in Boston.

Pollard has taught at Harding for 40 years, beginning in 1974, and served as associate dean of the College from 1992-97. He was twice awarded the Distinguished Teachers award (1988 and 1996) and presently serves on the editorial board of *Restoration Quarterly* and the *Stone-Campbell Journal*. Pollard has been active through the years in the Society of Biblical Literature and the Evangelical Theological Society by presenting papers and leading scholarly forums. He has published dozens of articles, contributed essays to several books, and spoken on most of the lectureships at brotherhood schools.

Over the years he has preached for many area congregations and served for 21 years as a minister for the Northside Church of Christ in Augusta, Ark. Presently, Pollard is an elder at the College Church of Christ in Searcy.

He is married to Dr. Sherry Pollard who teaches in the marriage and family therapy program and serves as a counselor. They have three children and seven grandchildren.



From 1976-1982, Shearin was chair of the music department and director of the Chorale at Freed-Hardeman. In 1982 he returned to Harding where he served as music department chair from 1993-2008. He directed the Concert Choir for two decades. In recent years he has taught studio voice, vocal pedagogy and diction courses, and music appreciation.

Shearin has held offices in the National Association of Teachers of Singing, National Association of Schools of Music, and Alpha Chi National Honor Scholarship Society. He also is a distinguished past president of the Searcy Kiwanis Club.

He is an elder at the College Church of Christ in Searcy where he serves on the worship committee and co-teaches an adult Sunday school class.

He and his wife, the former Sheri Tipps, have two children and five grandchildren.

HARDING UNIVERSITY

Harding University has a rich history of quality education. Harding was chartered as a senior college in 1924 when two junior colleges, Arkansas Christian College and Harper College, merged their facilities and assets, adopted the new name of Harding College, and located on the campus of Arkansas Christian in Morrilton, Ark. The school was moved to Searcy in 1934, and the Board of Trustees approved a recommended change of Harding to university status in 1979.

Harding was named in memory of James A. Harding, a pioneer Christian educator who founded Nashville Bible School (Lipscomb University) in Tennessee. He challenged his co-workers with an enthusiasm for Christian education that remains a significant tradition at Harding University.

At the charter, J.N. Armstrong, who had served five years as Harper's president, became president of Harding College.

In 1936, George S. Benson returned from mission work in China to assume the presidency of his alma mater. Benson directed the college from a deep indebtedness into a state of financial stability, national recognition and academic accreditation. He retired in 1965 after 29 years of tireless service.

Dr. Clifton L. Ganus Jr., a 1943 graduate, served as president from 1965 to 1987. A former history department chair and vice president of the college, Dr. Ganus kept alive his predecessors' drive for excellence by leading a plan of campus improvement and expansion. At his retirement, Dr. Ganus became Harding's first chancellor and is now chancellor emeritus.

Dr. David Burks became the fourth president in 1987. A 1965 graduate, he has been a member of the faculty since 1967 and has served as dean of the College of Business Administration. Under his leadership, the University experienced record growth in enrollment and giving and, more importantly, placed significant emphasis on Christian servanthood. The goal of his administration was the integration of faith, learning and living. Dr. Burks continues his service to Harding as chancellor.

Dr. Bruce McLarty, the University's fifth president, entered office in June 2013. Prior to this role, McLarty was the first vice president of spiritual life for the University, serving concurrently as dean of the College of Bible and Ministry until 2008, after which he retained the vice presidential role. As the result of his doctoral work, the University adopted his five-chapter curriculum, "Embracing the Mission," which focuses on maintaining the faith-based principles Harding was built upon. With that focus in mind, the University seeks to develop the whole person through a spiritual emphasis in academics, athletics, Bible classes and chapel. Thus, Harding's 6,295 students, representing all 50 states and 48 foreign countries, are empowered for ministry, church leadership and a lifetime of service.
