MINUTES OF SA COUNCIL MEETING  
May 8, 1963

The SA steak supper will be Tuesday, May 21.


It was mentioned that a Negro girl from Searcy who attends school in Terrell, Texas, is in great financial difficulties; she has been helped by students and faculty (esp. Billie Verkler) here before. Students are to work individually through the dorms, the classes, etc. Harmon will check with Dr. Benson as to other means also. If approved, Dr. Gilliam will bring this matter up at the faculty meeting Saturday. The total amount to be raised needs to be a minimum of \$150-175.

It was suggested that there are several items in the Student Handbook which need to be changed. Because of the time left in school, Joel Anderson suggested that these changes be taken to Virgil Lawyer (who writes the book) by the individual.

The problem of melting ice cream in the cafeteria was brought up for discussion; the discussion was left hanging because of interruptions.

The meeting was adjourned under great duress.
