DANIEL STOCKSTILL, PH.D.

Dr. Daniel Stockstill has served in numerous roles and on numerous committees since joining the Harding faculty in 1990, and will retire from the university this summer as associate dean of the College of Bible & Ministry. Previously, Dr. Stockstill served as assistant dean of the college from 2006-08 and was promoted to the rank of professor in 2009.

Dr. Stockstill is a 1976 graduate of Harding, earning a bachelor's degree in biblical languages and Bible. He completed a Master of Theology with emphasis in textual studies and textual criticism from Harding Graduate School of Religion in 1981 and in 1999, he completed a doctorate in practical theology from Union Institute and University. In addition to teaching at Harding, Dr. Stockstill spent 13 years serving directly in ministry and participated in ministry and leadership training as part of Klesis, a mission effort in Australia. He also served as a national director for Lads to Leaders.

He sponsored the Harding University Christian drama troupe Theatron from 1994-2004 and has spoken at various youth ministry and teacher training seminars and workshops throughout his career. Dr. Stockstill was also a lead researcher on a 10-year longitudinal study of the millennial generation in the churches of Christ as well as being involved with Uplift, a summer Bible camp, for more than 15 years. He is a member of Harding University President's Council.

Dr. Stockstill is a member of the Downtown Church of Christ where he has served as a shepherd since 2002, and also serves as a Bible class teacher.

He and his wife, Cindee Mansur Stockstill, have two children and four grandchildren.



Dr. Carroll holds a bachelor's degree in vocational home economics as well as a master's degree in secondary education, both from Harding. Her doctorate is in curriculum and instruction with an emphasis in elementary literacy from the University of Memphis. She has been a National Board Certified Teacher since 2003.

She and her husband of 43 years, Charlie Carroll, have two daughters and five grandchildren.

HARDING UNIVERSITY

Harding University has a rich history of quality education. Harding was chartered as a senior college in 1924 when two junior colleges, Arkansas Christian College and Harper College, merged their facilities and assets, adopted the new name of Harding College, and located on the campus of Arkansas Christian in Morrilton, Arkansas. The school was moved to Searcy in 1934, and the board of trustees approved a recommended change of Harding to university status in 1979.

Harding was named in memory of James A. Harding, a pioneer Christian educator who founded Nashville Bible School (now Lipscomb University) in Tennessee. He challenged his co-workers with an enthusiasm for Christian education that remains a significant tradition at Harding University.

At the charter, J.N. Armstrong, who had served five years as Harper's president, became president of Harding College, holding the office from 1924-36.

In 1936, George S. Benson returned from mission work in China to assume the presidency of his alma mater. Benson directed the college from a deep indebtedness into a state of financial stability, national recognition and academic accreditation. He retired in 1965 after 29 years of tireless service.

Dr. Clifton L. Ganus Jr., a 1943 graduate, served as president from 1965 to 1987. A former history department chair and vice president of the college, Ganus kept alive his predecessors' drive for excellence by leading a plan of campus improvement and expansion. At his retirement, Ganus became Harding's first chancellor and then served as chancellor emeritus from 2013 until his death in September 2019.

Dr. David Burks became the fourth president in 1987. A 1965 graduate, he has been a member of the faculty since 1967 and served as dean of the College of Business Administration. Under his leadership, the University experienced record growth in enrollment and giving and, more importantly, placed significant emphasis on Christian servanthood.

Dr. Bruce McLarty, a 1978 graduate and the University's fifth president, served as president from 2013 to 2020. Prior to this role, McLarty was the first vice president of spiritual life for the University. As the result of his doctoral work, the University adopted his five-chapter curriculum, "Embracing the Mission," which focuses on maintaining the faith-based principles Harding was built upon.

Chancellor David Burks resumed the role of president in December 2020 and serves until Harding's sixth president, Dr. Michael D. Williams, assumes the role on June 1, 2022. Like his previous administration, Dr. Burks' goal is the integration of faith, learning and living. With that focus in mind, the University seeks to develop the whole person through a spiritual emphasis in academics, athletics, Bible class and chapel. Thus, Harding's 4,970 students, representing 49 states and more than 50 countries and territories, are empowered for ministry, church leadership and a lifetime of service.
