## Student Association Minutes

The Council met at Dr. Gilliam's house on February 21,1967.
All members were present except Sherry Balthrop.

The first item of business was that of the Student Association Handbook. Prices of various plates for the printing of handbooks were quoted by DavidSmith. A committee was set up to work on the revision of the book.

The next topic of concern was the Youth Forum.1 David established three committees for planning the Forum: a Serving Committee, a Program Committee, and a Cleanup Committee. David encouraged all members of the Council to help with the Forum as much as possible.

Next the Gouncil talked about elections rules and constitutional amendments. David reported that John Black is checking into the problem.

David reported that an Academic Study is being considered at the present. He also reported that Academic Awards Acan be burchased for only 25¢. The group decided to purchase one hundred awards to supply the need for the next two and a half years.

Then David told the Council that April 15 has been set as the date for the Prayer Breakfast. He expressed his desire to attend if at all possible.

Linda Byrd was asked to work on the formation of a Council of Social Club Presidents. Lundy Neely and Dave Young were asked to work on the bulletin board rules.

The group talked about improving the parking situation for the married students. The problem was postponed until next year.

Next, David asked each member of the Council to be present at a luncheon at 12:00 pm Thursday, February 23. Dr. Ganus has asked that the SAnbe present for lunch and a discussion afterward.

Because there was no further business, the meeting was dismissed.
