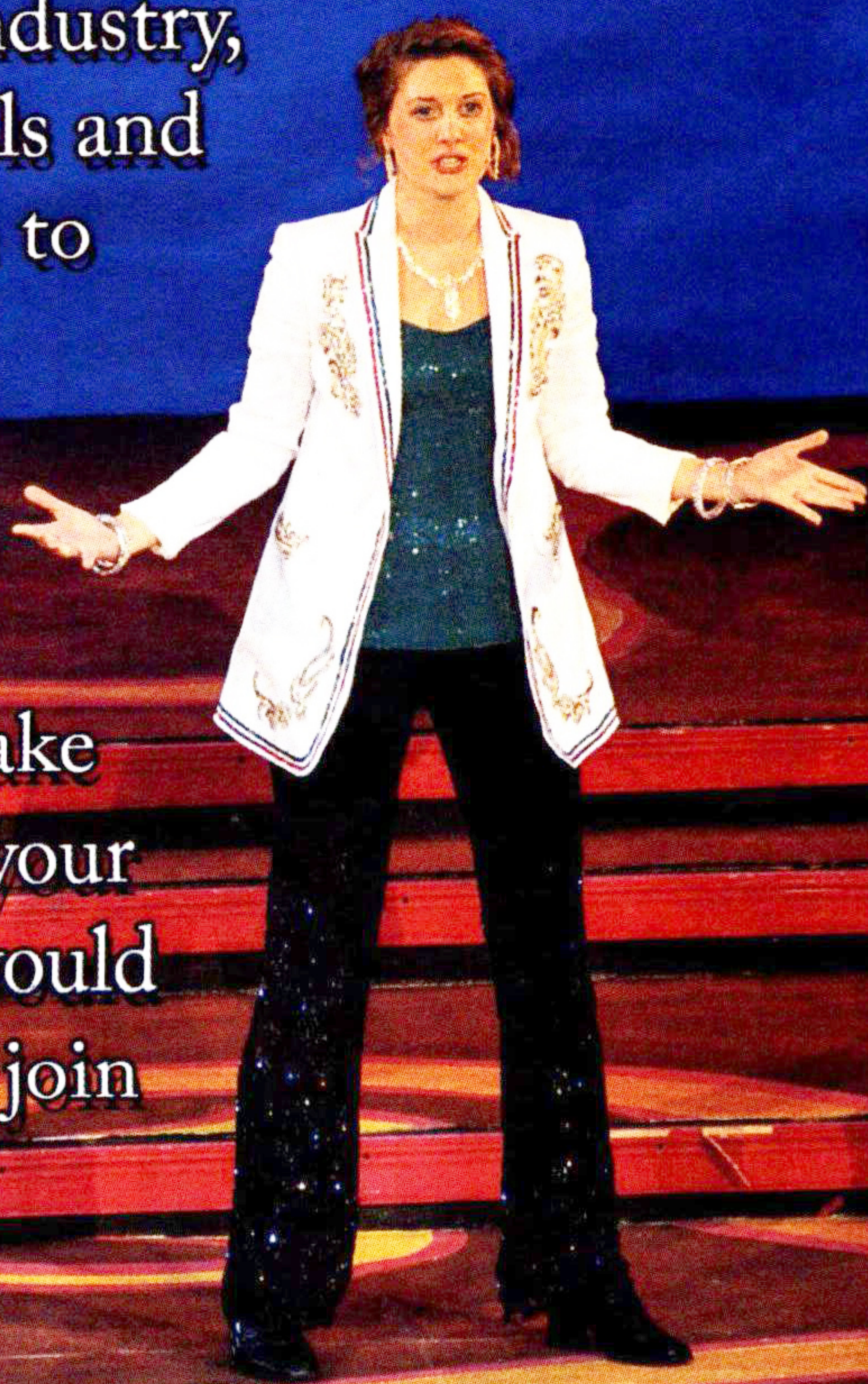


Faculty produced shows will give you the opportunity to learn under the guidance of seasoned educators who seek to expand your talent and develop your craft.
