INT:

One thing devoted Christian fears most: Found guilty of some unrealized sin at the judgment. II Tim.

Constant study is the best insurance against it. 2:15.

Our study: About the blackest of sins: Blasphemy. <sup>SIN</sup><sub>OF</sub>

My effort: Help all be sure they are free of it.

I. WHAT IS BLASPHEMY?

- A. To speak evil of God. II Samuel 12:14. *David.*
- B. Denial of the work and power of H. S. Text.
- C. Mistreatment of God's Son. Luke 22:65.
- D. Contradicting and abusing the gospel. Acts 13:45.
- E. Summary: Any antagonism against God, Christ, H. S., the Bible or the Church, *Christians.*
- F. Can you think of any time in which you injured any of these? It was blasphemy!!

*Musmur, complain, gossip is blasphemy!*

II. BLASPHEMY CAN BE CHARGED FALSELY.

- A. Was against Christ.
  1. Matt. 9:3. Healed palseyed man of sins & palsy.
  2. John 10:30-39. "I and my Father are one." *Stone.*
- B. Was against Stephen.
  1. Acts 6:9-15. Made by suborned witnesses.
- C. "By their fruits ye shall know them."
  1. Christ: "Father, forgive them ....."
  2. Stephen: "Lord, lay not this sin ....."
- D. Not the words of blasphemers. Mark 7:20-23.

III. SOME CHRISTIANS BLASPHEME TODAY.

- A. All unjust attacks on and charges against Christ's church are blasphemy. *Set up denominations in blasph.* I Tim. 1:13.
  1. Have you ever unjustly treated a member of Christ's sacred body-Church? You a blasphemer.
  2. That's what Paul did. He called it blasphemy!
- B. Dishonest service as an employee is blasphemy.
  1. Your God is blasphemed when you cheat. I T. 6:1.
  2. God is judged by you, His children; workmen.
- C. Wives who disobey their husbands blaspheme God and His holy Word. Titus 2:5.
  1. Woe unto husband who CAUSES wife to blaspheme.
  2. Woe unto the wife who brings reproach upon God.
- D. Conclusion: Any conduct which brings mockery upon God, His Son, His Spirit, His Book, or His Church is Blasphemy.

IV. BLASPHEMY, THE UNPARDONABLE SIN. Matt. 12:30-33.

A. What is this UNPARDONABLE SIN?

1. Denial of God's last provision for our salvation. John 14:26.
2. Point at which a person loses the desire to return to God. Then cannot return.
3. Two reasons he cannot return to God.
  - a. Heb. 10:26. Sin is open, wilful, planned.
  - b. Heb. 6:4-6. Too far gone to face world.

B. Who commits the unpardonable sin?

1. Former Christian, who knew better, but is in gall of bitterness.
2. Hopless because will to fight sin has died forever within his heart.

INV: What is the surest way to avoid blasphemy and the terrible unpardonable sin?
