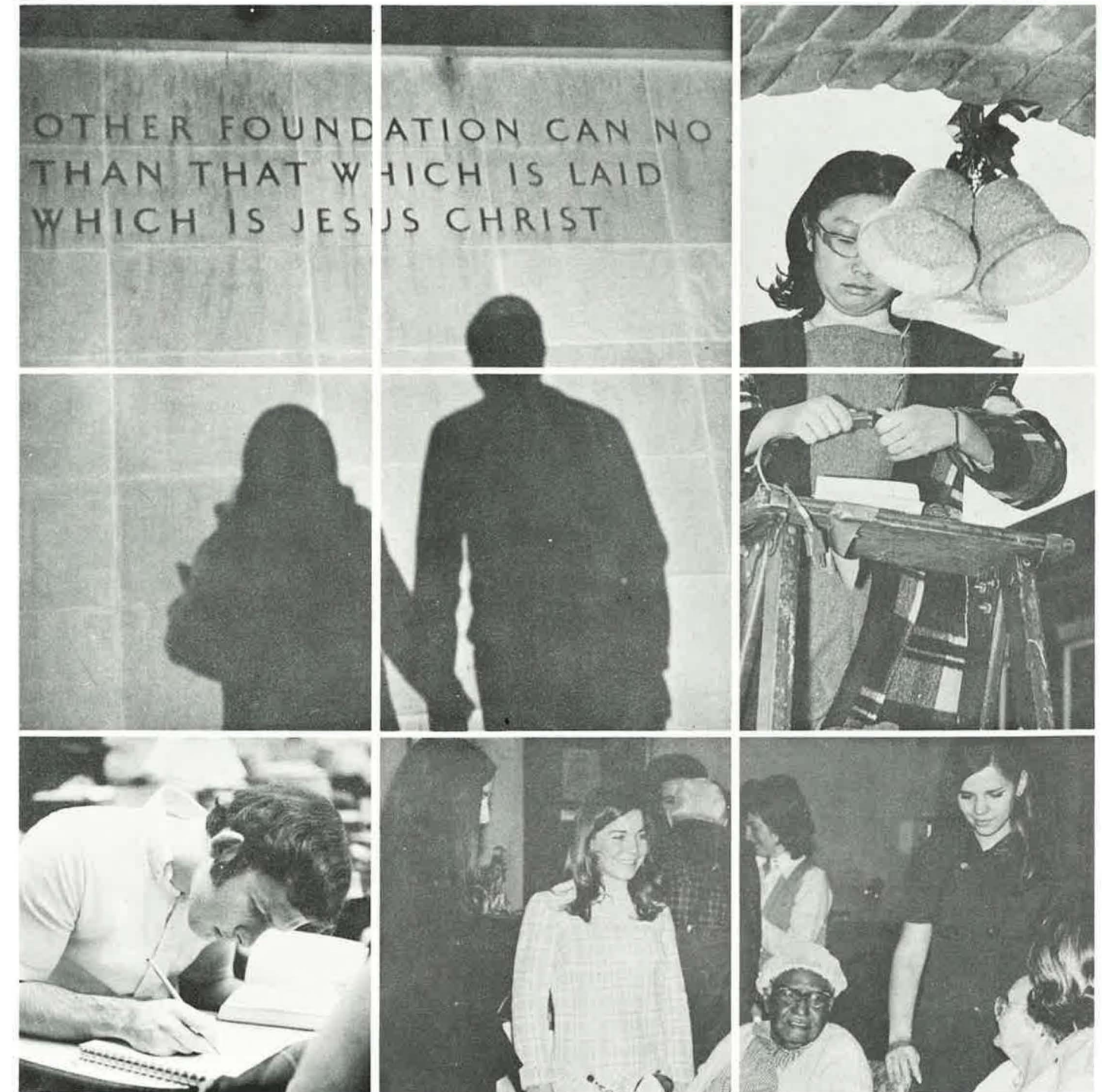
# Opportunity
