Dear Brother Chalk:

I am sorry to be late in answering your letter of the 14th of last month due to the fact that I have been out of town and have been pretty much buried with work since coming back, thus the delay.

The Teacher's Magazine will definitely be forthcoming and there will be a program of catching up with our issues which is going to take a little time. The main reason for it being behind time is that the publisher having brought the magazine from a bankrupt state had to assume some four thousand dollars indebtedness and then carry another approximately indebtedness per month in order to fulfil the paid subscriptions which he took up. Most of the subscriptions now are being renewed and thus he is getting some money to operate on and with this can afford to forge ahead and get on schedule now. Of course another serious error was made when the magazine was put put back into publication, that is that it began with a two and a half month-old date on the first issue. If it had started with the August or September issue put out in August of 1957 then it would have been no problem. Of course the date on the front of the page does make it look somewhat bad but most of the articles which are included there in are written prior to the season in which the magazine will come.

Thank you for your enquiry and also for your business with us in our bookstore. We appreciate your interest in both very much. We do hope that you can find it possible to put a Teacher's Magazine in hand of every Bible School teacher.
