DR. ENGIAND--Dr. England spoke to the council concerning the blood donor's club. The Harding faculty is a member of the group club. The
student body is already donating at a rate high enough to be a member
of the group. As a student body we would receive the benefits of the
group program. A student, his parents, and his grandparents would be
covered for the blood needs. It would require 25% (500 students) of
the student body to donate a pint a year in order to be covered by the
program. Gerald moved that we become a member of the Arkansas Group
Blood Program as a unit effective as of January 1, 1972. The motion
passed.
