STUDENT ASSOCIATION EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Student Association Executive Council was held Monday, November 5, 1973 with Mike Justus presiding. The meeting was called to order at 5:23 p.m. beginning with a prayer led by Lot Therrio.

PRESENT: Mike Justus, Elaine Shipp, Becky Cochran, Mark McInteer, Brenda Dimitt, Nancy Cochran, Lot Therrio, Michelle Pullara, Lee Trotter, Charlene Dietrich and Benny Sims.

ABSENT: Phil Herrington, David House, Dan Daniel, Darrell Bruning.

CAFETERIA COMMITTEE: Nancy and Becky met with Dr. Ganus for lunch in Patti Cobb one day last week and told Dr. Ganus about the complaints which they had received. He made explanation for all that they brought to him. Further action will be considered at next week's meeting.

PING PONG TABLES: Lot reported that there were no new developments.

CLUB EMBLEMS: Mark moved that we should drop the subject of putting back up the club emblems. The motion was seconded, but failed to carry. Other action was postponed until next week's meeting so that Darrell Bruning would be present to take charge.

PHYSICAL PLANT: There were no new developments on the physical plant committee.
