OLD BUSINESS

- A. ELECTIONS: Petitions for Upperclassman officers' positions are due on September 13th by 10:00p.m. Intent to file forms for Married Student Representative to the SA are also due the 13th. Intent to file forms for Freshman SA Representatives and Freshman class officers are due also on the 13th. Petitions for Married Students' SA Representative to the SA are due on the 17th. Petitions for Freshman class officers and SA Representatives are due on the 20th by 10:00 p.m. Elections for Upperclass officers and the Married Students' Representative will be held on the 22nd. Elections for the Freshman class officers and SA Representatives will be held on the 29th.
- B. Saturday is our first football game against Lane College. It is here and will begin at 7:30p.m. Friday night at 6:30 there will be a pep rally on the front lawn at 6:30.
