Dear Brother Caruthers,

I am writing once more in regard to our proposed effort this summer. You will remember in a letter under January 2, 1961 date, I indicated a conflict of one day in my meeting schedule for Adamsville. That day is July 16, Sunday, when I will be closing a meeting in Fulton, Miss.
