I. THE EVENTS OF THURSDAY BEFORE THE CRUCIFIXION.

- A. The Passover and instituting of Lord's Supper. 22:1-39.
- B. Agony in Gethsemane, betrayal and arrest, denials. 40-65
(Kangeroo court before figurehead Annas.)

II. FRIDAY WAS TRIAL AND CRUCIFIXION DAY.

- 6:00 AM A. Caiaphas, high priest, and sanhedrian heard him. 66^{27:} and.
- 6:30 B. Pilate heard the trumped up charges and cleared him. 16^{23:}
- 7:30 C. Herod heard the case and learned nothing. 7-12.
- 8:30 D. Pilate reasoned with the Jews to no avail. 23:13-26.
Pilate threatened with mass demonstration-gave in.
- 9:00 E. Jesus hung on the cross. Darkness 12~~---~~ 3:00 p.m.
- F. Body of Jesus entombed by 5:30 by Josephus & Nicodemus.

 - b. On fire with courage for Jesus. Phil. 4:13. ^{Too small}
 - c. On fire with determination to do well. I C. 15:58.
 - d. On fire with quiet fanaticism. Rev. 2:10. IIt. 2:24.
 - e. On fire for souls. Mk. 16:15-16. II Cor. 5:11.
3. Request **4 things** of each of you. ^{2nd call, if not first!}
 - a. Say "Yes" when called to serve. Later, if not now.
 - b. Lay aside less important things. First things first
 - c. Keep on keeping on. Gal. 6:9. ^{MAT. 6:33.}
 - d. Give God and Christ all the Glory. Col. 3:17.
