IN THE BEGINNING-MAN (Origin)

Gen. 2:1-3 (Repeat of Ch. 1-Details.)

INT:

Gen. 1:1 is timeless. Time begins with 1st day-Light.
 Next five days: Firmament, plants, planets, fish and
 fowl, animals and man. 7th-day of cessation.

Chapter 2 deals with 7 major topics: Sabbath, plants,
 garden, man, woman, marriage and the home.

I. SABBATH was the SEVENTH day and a day of REST.

- All early nations record such.
- A. Not idleness, but contemplation, remember, thanks.
1. First mention of strict observance: Ex. 16:22.
 2. First mention as LAW! 30 days later. 1491. 20:8
 3. Strictly observed by the Jews. Num. 15:32. Sticks
 4. Observed until superceeded by First Day. A.20:7.

II. PLANTS CREATED TO SERVE AND SUSTAIN ANIMAL-HUMAN LIFE.

- A. No plants on second day. 4004 B. C. No rain. V. 5.
- B. Earth first softened by mist, then plants began to
 grow on the 3rd day. 1:11-13. Full-grown; seed.
- C. Plants put in Delightful & Pleasant Garden: Eden.
1. Adam to dress and keep the garden varieties.
 2. Ate of all fruit, including Tree of Life, but 1.
 3. Forbidden to eat of Tree of Knowledge of G & E.

III. DETAILS OF MAN'S ORIGIN. 2:7. Clay in the Potter's hand

- A. From Dust. (Carbon, hydrogen, nitrogen, lime, iron,
 sulphur, phosphorus, sodium-chloride, magnesium etc

- B. Dust represents Death, The Grave. Gen. 3:19, 18:27
 V. 19. Job. 10:9, 34:15, Ecc. 12:7. Humbling!!!!

- C. Woman: She-man, womb-man. (J. D. Tant. Bull-he-cow.)

1. From man's SIDE. Bone and flesh. Vs. 23.
2. Help-meet: "One like, stands before, helper."
3. Adam names his help-meet, the animals of earth,
 and all the plants, trees and shrubs.

IV. CHAPTERS I & II CONTAIN MANY MANY FIRSTS OF HUMAN RACE

1. First man, woman, animals, fish, fowl, plants-plane
2. First vocabulary, language, articulate speech.
 (Not grunts & growls of a primeval aboriginal etc.)
3. First week of time, spent in creating new things.
4. First rest, cessation from labor, blessed, set apar
5. First work: Dress and keep the garden. V. 15.
6. First law: Abstain from Tree of Knowledge of G & E.
7. First minerals: V. 12. Gold, bdellium, onyx stone.

- 8. First home: a garden. All cultures begin life in a garden.
- 9. First mention of "father and mother." Family ties. Husband-wife ties greater than child-parent ties.
- 10. First state of man: Perfect, sinless, innocent. **SIN**, which came later, destroyed that perfection, sinlessness and innocence. Chapter 3.
