Matt. 7:13-20

Goal: Every person present in harmony with his God.

Int. Jesus' View: Matt. 22:14, Matt. 7:21-23, Matt. 7:13-14.

Explains these warnings: Rom. 3:23, 6:23, Gal. 6:7-8, John 5:28-29.

Lesson: 5 reasons most prefer to go to Hell.

I Rather BELOST than obey our Lord. How know? Mk. 16:15-16
answer: Most are not obeying teachings of Christ. Lk. 12:47-48

II Rather run with evil companions than go to Heaven.
A. I Cor. 15:33. cannot do both. Most run with evil companions. Rev. 21:27

III Rather lose his soul than sit with hypocrites in the church.

A. Test: Get off plane if find a (crook) hypocrite on it? Leave football game? Theater? Bus?

B. Choice: Tolerate them a little while here and be rid of them forever OR avoid them now and suffer with them in Hell forever? as bad! most abiding them now; companions forever.

IV Rather go to torment than to give liberally.

A. I Cor. 16:2, II Cor. 9:6-8. 10% a beginning.
B. most not doing this: 30% gives 90%. 70%-10%.

V Rather lose Heaven than give total dedication.

A. Luke 17:10, I Pet. 4:18.
B. Not obligated to those "extra" services! Explain I Cor. 15:58
