HOW WELL DO YOU WORSHIP GOD?

John 4:19-24 \*

INT: It makes a difference with God: **WHOM** you worship. **HOW** you worship. **WHAT** you worship. **WHEN** you worship & **WHERE!**  
**Study: Personal evaluation of our worship to God.**

- I. APPROACH. Why do you go? Heb. 10:24-27. *Serve God!*
- A. Should not matter about the preacher, elders etc.  
III. "No Mr. Henry W. Beecher not be here, but God will!"  
 1. Too many children & youth not familiar. "Which wayman"  
 2. Many miss point. "Momma, after that circus, church is going to be kind of hard to go to, isn't it??"
- II. SING: Why? Eph. 5:19. Col. 3:16. I Cor. 14:15. *Praise God!*
- A. Careful about being critical of others.  
III. "Well, you can't preach very well either!!!"  
 1. Sing: Prayer song:  
 2. Sing: Praise song: *Wonderful, wonderful!*
- III. PRAY: Why? How? I Thess. 5:17. I Tim. 2:1. 2:8. *Speak to God!*
- A. Can pray anytime. Bro. \_\_\_\_\_ please lead us in prayer!  
III. Preachers have to be careful not to get too smart with the deacons. Tried to catch one asleep. Did. Asked for short-special prayer. Deacon woke up, thought service over, dismissed aud. All went home
- IV. PREACH. Why? Mark 16:15-16. II Cor. 5:10-11. How? E. 4:15. *Tell about God!*
- III. Church looking for preacher. Two came. Both preached on Hell. Rich member said, "get the last one!" Why? Both preached on Hell. First one enjoyed it. Last one, it hurt to tell us about it
- V. COMMUNE: Why? Acts 20:7. I Cor. 11:23-29.\* Every week!
- A. Gets too common: Same of meeting, singing, praying and giving??? Do it all the same amount. Quit???
- B. Is too much trouble: I John 5:3. Bro. Batsell Barrett Baxter & son used to go to wife and mother's grave whenever could meet there. Too much trouble; too expensive?? Never. Place of sweetest of memories!
- VI. GIVE: Why? I Cor. 16:2. II Cor. 9:6-8.
- A. Too many like little boy had 2 nickles. Stumped toe. Had one nickle for God & one for ice cream. Lost one. Said: "Oops, Lord, there went your nickle."
- B. Or, like the rich lady. No motion to give when plate started by. Little boy got nervous. Finally more than could stand. Said, "Here lady you give my quarter and I'll hide under the seat."
