It was a pleasure to get your letter concerning a proposed gospel meeting with the Huber Heights congregation in 1964. I appreciate the invitation but feel that I probably should decline it for that year due to the proposed meeting with the Riverdale congregation in the spring of 1964. However, I do not have a firm date with them and would appreciate your checking with some of your friends there concerning whether they are expecting me next year or not. If they have dropped their plans for my coming, I will be happy to come to Huber Heights. I would also be unable to come in 1965 due to a Fall meeting with the Northridge congregation but would be happy to make definite plans and schedule a definite date for 1966. Your reply concerning this matter will be awaited.
