SUBJECT: John Allen Chalk

Please remember that you are invited, as my guest, to the Presbyterian Mens Club supper Thursday evening February 21, 6:00 P. M. You told me, as I remember , that you will just meet me at the church.

Please tell John Allen that I plan to spend about 2 minutes setting up some background for his talk on the subject: THIS I BELIEVE. My remarks will emphasize facts such as these: (1) We are in crises much of which is internal, (2) We have juvenile and youth delinquency both largely a result of adult delinquency, and (3) Adult delinquency may be caused, at least partially, by a lack of deep and fundamental beliefs. This is background for the talk.
