Dear Brethren:

We are all thrilled to know that your building is so near completion. The last few months have been trying I am sure.

I am pleased at the prospect of working with you in a gospel meeting next year. The week of May 3, 1964, would be acceptable to me. My only concern is with the problem of two Sundays in the meeting.
