Dear Brethren:

Since May of this year, I have followed with extreme interest the program of evangelism being planned by the Queens Church of Christ in connection with the New York World's Fair. At the invitation of the Queens congregation, I was permitted to work in a three day planning session last week in New York. Out of my personal acquaintance with you, the tremendous opportunity to reach a potential audience of eight million people, I am writing at my own instigation to ask your support in this program.

The Queens brethren, with their church building less than one mile from the fair site, are sure that they can carry on an effective program of every phase during 1964-65 at the Worlds Fair at a cost of \$400,000. Knowing of your unusual interest in the work of the Church, I am writing to ask that you give careful consideration to supporting this work. Many congregations are budgeting only \$10 per month for the next two years. Other congregations are giving larger amounts. I am convinced that every dollar spent in this project will be fully utilized toward the important goal of permanently affecting thousands of people.

The Queens congregation, P. O. Box 128, Flushing, New York, 11352 will be happy and thrilled to know of any decision you make to support this work.
