Dear Brethren:

This letter is written to request your aid in the conversion of Mrs. Al Graham, 2601 Hughes, Amarillo, Texas. Mrs. Graham is a native of Cookeville. During the past two summers she has visited in Cookeville for six to eight weeks at a time. Although a nominal person she and her three sons attended every service of this congregation. She is reading the Bible extensively and recently attended one of the congregations in your city several times without feeling and being welcomed in the least.

Due to difficulties with her husband, a very busy and successful construction company owner, she attempted suicide. After spending several weeks in a Louisville, Kentucky hospital and some time in Cookeville, she has now returned to your city and to her home. Our mistake was not in realizing the depth of her sincerity during her last summers visit and using the opportunity to teach her the truth. We now have a standing appointment with her for her next extended visit to Cookeville but feel that she could be induced to begin attending the services of the Church in your city.

Any attention which you can show this woman will be appreciated by all of her friends in Cookeville. You will find her an extremely personable and fair-minded individual.
