Dear Brethren:

On Sunday afternoon, April 28, at 5:00 p.m. the Elders of this congregation met to consider the Final Report and Recommendations of the General Planning Committee—a committee the Elders had ordered into existence.

The result of this meeting last Sunday afternoon was a unanimous "decision that the Broad Street Church of Christ, now meeting at 155 East Broad Street, relocate at the new site on South Jefferson Avenue according to further plans of the Elders." This is the exact wording of the minutes of the April 28 meeting.

Enclosed you will find a copy of the General Planning Committee's report which caused the Elders to make the above decision. Please read the first ten pages very carefully. If you have any question about the suggestions in those ten pages you may look to the Appendix for the basis for every recommendation made.

A special congregational meeting has been called for Sunday evening, May 5, at 7 p.m. Every member of the congregation should obviously be present for this historic meeting. Any questions, doubts, oppositions and suggestions will be welcomed.
