"What Jesus Said and Did." ^(1.) ^{Greatest Story ever told!}

Four areas of revelation in N.T. comprize the total Biblical-story of Jesus:
1. Birth (Christmas) (celebrated) 52 times!
2. Life (?) 52!
3. Death (Lord's Supper) (celebrated) 52!
4. Resurrection. (Easter) (celebrated) 52!

Question: How & when do we celebrate the "LIFE" of Jesus?
Does Paul tell in I Cor. 11:2? II Cor. 3:2? ^{Light me/you!} John 8:12. ^{Matt. 5:14} Every day! 365!

The Life of Christ in a capsule.
A. Acts 10:38. "did good!" Acts 1:1. - "all" in Luke.
B. Purpose of His life's story: John 20:30-31. Done.

Today's Lesson: a brief sketch of a busy Jesus.
A. Matt. 9:35 says it well. Covered over 125 cities & villages. ^{on that} ^(Josephus) ³⁶⁵
B. Nine Periods covered in 33 yrs: ^{make it real} ³⁶⁵ Birth to Trip to Jordan River at Jericho.

- 1. Preparation. (30 yrs) Birth to Trip to Jordan River at Jericho.
- 2. Inauguration: (15 Mo.) Entry into public life. Inc. ---
Bop. - Pomp - marriage at Cana - 1st Passover. ^{Feast.}
- 3. Early Galilean Ministry. (4 mos.) Visited 6 places. ---
Rejected at Naz. - 2nd Passover. Sermon on Mt.
- 4. Later Galilean Min. (20 mos.) Visited 6 places. ---
Sermon on Mt. to feeding 5,000. (opposition setting in)
- 5. Retreated from hostile areas. (6 mos.) --- ^{gentile territory.}
Tyne & Sidon. Decapolis (10 cities) E. of Jordan. ^{teaching & healing.}
Dal-manu-tha. Bethsaida. Caesarea Philippi + Capernaum. ^{teaching & healing.} 2,000!
- 6. Judean Ministry (3 mos.) Feast of Tabernacles to Feast of Dedication.
- 7. Perean Ministry. (4 mos.) Most time E. of Jordan with two short visits to Bethany. ^{Prophecies + fulfillment.}
- 8. Passion week. Consumes 30% of Gospels. ^{Shame!}
Week of stress, dread, sorrow, pain & death on the cross. ^{Shame!}
- 9. Post-Resurrection month + 10 days. (40 days).
appearances: Mary, Women, men of Emmaus. The 10. The 11. ^{later.}
(Peter) 7. ^{Jer.} ^{mt. Olivet.} ^{500.} James. (Eleven at ascension.)

c. Some of Christ's Tenderest Moments.

- 1. Matt. 4:22-25. Overwhelming power in an overwhelming heart of love. Healed. Preached. Touched.
- 2. Lk. 7:11-16. ^{main:} Manifested God's glory & might. Don't weep!
- 3. Matt. 14:14-21 + 15:32-39. Fed 5,000 + 4,000 students in Desert. Mt. near the sea of G.
- 4. Matt. 19:13-15 + 18:1-4. Evaluated children.
- 5. John 11:1-27. Jesus wept. Tender sympathetic. Caring.

Summary: Jesus dealt with Disease + illness, pain, death + grief, hunger + thirst, innocent little children and separation in families because of death. He dealt with it all: phy., material, emotional, intellectual, psychological + spiritual.

Inw. all of this story explains Eph. 1:15-23. Small God has to offer! Enough!

EPH. 1:19-23 explains why Christians sing:

HE IS MY EVERYTHING, HE IS MY ALL.

HE IS MY EVERYTHING, BOTH GREAT AND SMALL.

HE GAVE HIS LIFE FOR ME, MADE EVERYTHING NEW.

HE IS MY EVERYTHING. NOW, HOW ABOUT YOU?
