INT: (*) MATT. 10:1-16. (Let's PLAY-LIKE!) Envision yourself in this era 1964 yrs. ago. WHERE?..... HOW?....would you fit into this exciting period of the church....? -period of PREPARATION----early stages. Laying the ground-work for Pentecost !!! * This seemento was played out beautifully six years later by the Jerusalem church of Christ. • Acts 8:1-4. QUESTION: Who? did this? CHRISTIANS !! Men preached or gospelized. Women and children SHARED or TAUGHT others. WHAT PART WOULD you HAVE BEEN PLAYING THEN? Talking and telling?
