IV. BARNABAS WAS SHREWD, ASTUTE & DISCERNING of human natur

- Acts 15:35-39. Very balanced thinker. Sweet-of-hear

- II Tim. 4:11. Barnabas' ENCOURAGEMENT won out over Paul's skepticism and tough-love approach to training young men for the ministry. Jun Mark.

a. This one from Jesus, Paul's Hero: @Matt. 11:28-30.

- Been struggling with a PROBLEM? Can't get a handle on it? Christ specializes in handles-ofproblems. S John 14:6. acts 2', 38. Sinnets.
- Not in the Kingdom---the Lord's church, His Spr. family? Why not? I'll compare "reasons" with you. YOU give me <u>3</u> reasons you are <u>not</u> a N.T. Christian. Have that many? I'll give you 9 reasons you should be bap. into Christ. 3 to 1
- 3. You....a wandering disciple of Christ. Not anchored. Not under wisdom and guidance of <u>Elders</u> --the Lord's Way ---THEN shouldn't you BE somewhere? Why not here.....Now!
