INTRO:	LESSON demands 3 definitions and 1 Question Answered:
	<ul> <li>A. THREE DEFINITONS:</li> <li>1. JESUS - Matt. 16:13-18. SON OF GOD, Savior, King and Final Judge.</li> <li>2. FRIEND- One who knows all about you and still loves you!</li> <li>3. SINNERS- I John 3:4. TRANSCRESSORS OF GOD*S LAW. Romans 3:23. + James 4:17. Willful procrastinators. Know better</li> </ul>
	B. SOME VITAL DISTINCTIONS:
	1. Jesus NEVER loved Satan, Sin nor any Unrightousness.
	2/ Jesus ALWAYS loved the Sinner. John 3:16. / Rom. 5:1-2;6;8-11.
	3. Jesus NEVER compromised with sin nor the sinner. No "go along to get along
	4. Jesus NEVER refused to HELP a sinner turn to God and abandon sin/idea. (Naturally demanded 'association", but not <u>'fellowship'</u> until on same side.
	5. Jesus Commissioned His Disciples to DEAL with sinners, as He did. Matt. 5:13-14. Be a <u>LIGHT</u> strong and bright! Be <u>SALT</u> strong and brave. Not John 17:15. of!
	C. OLD ADAGE: "THE PROOF OF THE PUDDING IS IN THE" Tasting.
	1. Jesus tasted the Púdding by time and again confronting sin - kindly in love.
	a. JOHN 3:1-16. A CURIOUS AND SPIRITUAL PHARISEE OF THE JEWS.
	Could have "nailed" him. Matt. 23:13-15; 37-38.
	INSTEAD: Spoke of hope and eternal glory. John 3:3-5. (1. <u>As Christians</u> , we can also welcome sinners to <u>share</u> the Greatest Story ever Told <u>prepare</u> for the eternal joy of Heaven
	<ul> <li>b. JOHN \$:1-42. A CURIOUS AND MISTAKEN PAGAN WOMAN OF SAMARIA. Could have #nailed" this Pagan to the wall - and did in a sly and kindly way. Vs. V. 21-244</li> <li>Woman, a poor judge of men.5 Poor judge of <u>Religions</u>, Ugly and argumentative. Soured on world, esp. men!</li> <li>JESUS spoke of "Living Water", Hope, Forgiveness and eternal glory!</li> <li>(1). As Christians, we can compare our "Religion" kindly with all others. Best to JUST OFFER ITrather than <u>argue</u> it.</li> </ul>
	c. JOHN 8:1-12. A SORROWFUL SEXUAL SINNER who awaited rescue. WOMAN'S PLIGHT: Marriage, home-family or Prostitution! NO outside work for salaried women. Terrible social situat
	Mean Jewish Leaders wanted to <u>banish</u> her and Jesus at the <u>same time</u> . Knew couldn't <u>stone</u> her because of the Romans. ACCUSERS vanished in the light of TRUTH and MERCY. JESUS: SPOKE to her of Forgiveness, Hope and Purity of life NONE had qualified to CONDEMN AND PUNISH HER. V. V.11-12.
	<ul> <li>(1. As Christians: we can show sinners THE BETTER WAY and offer them Forgiveness and Redemption through the Gospel.</li> <li>III. FIRST CHOICE, (Salvation Army rescue home for drug addicted women. All have children- most out of wedlock. Chloe Carter &amp; Dana Sager leading them by the tens to Baptism and Reformation of Life.</li> </ul>
