 - 2. ILL. JUSTIN Omni theater later Intro. Helicopter roars ever head...
 - 3. Question: How many rel. songs do we have dealing with this subject? 3... - ANSWER: AAvery-close relationship with the Lord: Thick or Thin!!
 - 4. QUESTION: A LATE REPORT: Which is the world's FAVORITE hymn today? Answer : "I come to the Garden Alone". Read Vs. 1-2. 50 NG.

- A. What does the NEW TESTAMENT say:
 - 1. 8 I John 1:5-7. Note: Tense of the verb-Cleansing! Keeps on cleansing! Continues to cleanse us!!! An on-going PROCESS.
 - Ill. As long as we walk in the light Jesus CONTINUES to cleanse us from our sins. Second-law-of-Pardon for the Christian??
 - Ill. I, bap. at age 12. Have NEVER felt lost since that day!WHY? Never let ANYTHING stand between me and my LORD! Nothing. QUESTION: Was I saved the day of my baptism? Saved everyday SINCE - as long as I dealt with my sins CONCLUSION: THEN, should I feel that I am saved tonight? YOU ??
 - 2. I John 2:24-25. As long as obeying the Goapel, then have E.L.!!

 QUESTION: Then, should I feel I have eternal life NOW? Any difference in Salvation, in Christ's continual cleansing, and eternal life?? 83:14. \$5:11-13. ARE we then, SAFE in the arms of jesus now? If not, why not???

IS IT POSSIBLE that his life from the baptistry to the Judgment is uninterrupted-eternal life. The first part is lived in time and the second part begins at the Judgment, when all things are made FINAL in eternal timelesness?

III. FORMAT # 2. WERE FAOTHFUL N.T. CHRISTIANS AFRAID OF DEATH AND SHOULD TODAY'S FAITHFUL CHRISTIAN BE AFRAID TO DIE -- or does a Total-Committment to Jesus today eliminate any FEAR of dying???

1. HONESTEY --- How many of us are afraid of Death? Class response

Ill. How many can be like Carol Staley's mother who died by APPOINTMENT in All Saints hospital at exactly 2 p.m. one Thursday?

- 2. WHY GREAT CHRISTIANS OF THE PAST WERE NOT AFRAID TO DIE!!!
- a. Phil. 4:11 & 4:13. "Put your hand in the hand of the MAN (calmed the sea...)..who STILLED THE WATERS"....etc. Hand in hand with Jesus !!!
 - b. Phil. 1:19-20. Paul's <u>BODY</u> was a TEMPLE for the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. Not MY body, but God's for His uses!

 Phil. 2:5 MIND a dwelling-place of Christ's <u>mind</u>. The <u>SOUL</u>,

a RESERVOIR of Christ's Spirit and Wisdom. James 1:5-8.

Note: Paul's life was locked into the express-IMAGE of Christ in his behavior and life-style.

- c. Phil. 1:21-26. Paul considered <u>DEATH</u> a friend who would guide him to the glorious-reunion with Jesus in Heaven!
- d. DEATH, in Paul's day was an early visitor to most. Ave. age+span 46 yrs. In the USA in 1925 the ave. life-span was only 49.Why
 - ANS.: Poor diet. Poor hygene. Little medical knowledge. Disease: Poor diagnoses. Punishing work schedules.
 - ANS: DEATH was a freedom-giver from: Leprosy, Blindness, cancer paralysis, leukemia, disbetes, MD, MS, HANDICAPS, polio, meningitis, heart-attacks, strokes, brain tumors, aneurysms, and starvation, etc.
- e. PAUL looked at DEATH as a freedom TO: Perfect health, eyesight, hearing, in a Spr. body like Christ's. ETERNAL: well-being.
