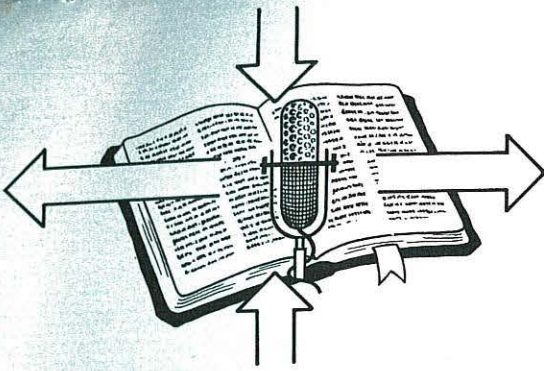
We hope that by now the water shortage in Sao Paula is over. I send you and all your colleagues my respect and regards. It will be great seeing you in February.
