Corretta King has written a new book, just published by Holt, Rinehart & Winston, entitled My Life with Martin Luther King, Jr. I need some sensitive person to read and review this book for our service. The "Guidelines for Reviewers" are attached to this letter. Remember the kind of person we are aiming at in our reviews, especially spiritually, hungry church members who are either college students or college trained who are now in the business world, and write from your own viewpoint as Christian wife and mother.

If for some reason you aren't able to get a copy of the book, or if you don't feel that you can do this, please let me know immediately. If, however, you will take the challenge, I will look forward to getting your review by March 1, 1970. Think seriously about this because I think the book is an excellent book that can help a lot of housewives and mothers to become more sensitive to their own tasks and more concerned about their relationships to their own husbands and children.

You might want to consult Saturday Review, October 11, 1969, page 33, for a review of this book by Adele Silver, just to get another reviewer's insights. But I want the review you write to be your own personal reactions, as a Christian woman, to the book.
