Dear brother John,

Thank you very much for the help you gave me with Cookeville. When you get a bill for that phone call, let me know what it is.

I talked with you on the phone from Nashville Monday about 2:00 p.m. (June 15th). About 5:30p.m. I received a call from Bob McMillan asking me to be there at 7:30 for a meeting with the committee. We were there -met with them for about three hours. They asked me to send a resume with open dates I could come and preach for them. They had been unsuccessful in reaching Judge Mitchell. I asked the Lord for a fleece -we arrived in Davenport Tuesday evening; awaiting us was a letter from Judge Mitchell. He apparently knew nothing of what had transpired with Cookeville and me. I don't know where he got my name. I was impressed that the Lord was in it. His letter was written Sunday (June 14th) and mailed Monday morning in Nashville. I mailed a resume about the 17th with open dates of the 12th & 19th of July. On the 1st of July I called brother McMillan. He said they were interested in me but were trying another man on the 5th and if they reached no agreement with him, they would be talking to me about that work. I expected a phone call but none has come (Tuesday) so they have possibly made an agreement with the other man.

If you know of any possibilities in Texas where I might work out, I would appreciate knowing.

I need your prayers that He will put me where He wants and that I will be willing to accept His decision.
