We were interested in hearing of the guidance God had given you for your future. Nelson and I are certain you and many others will be blessed by your association with Sweet B. Many times during the past months you have had a special place in our communication with our Father. Our prayers will continue to be with you.

And as Nelson & I reflected we realized that at the same time He is opening doors for all of who depend on Him.

We will be leaving for Hong Kong May 30, the Lord willing. Our flight leaves San Francisco at that time.
