I am sorry we did not get to visit either at the Christian College of the Southwest fund raising dinner or at the Harding Lectureship. It was a pleasure to see you again, however.

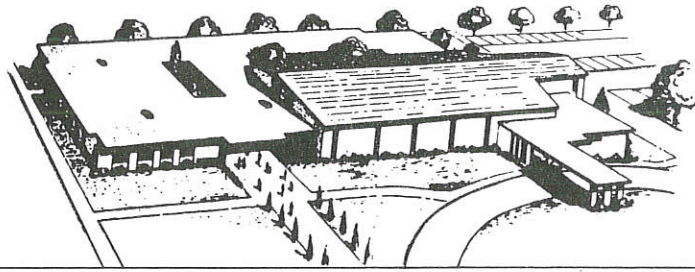
