I have a great interest in Fort Worth Christian College and send you my very best wishes for a good year and a successful fall "kick-off" luncheon.

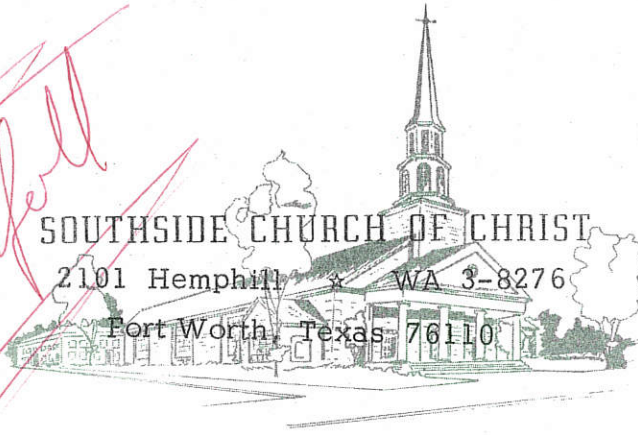
